This cause coming to be heard was submitted upon the Bill of Complaint, ~~Decree Pro Confession~~ Answer and Waiver filed by the respondent on the 22nd day of March, 1950

and testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in her said Bill:

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Respondent be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and the said Doris A. Kidd is forever divorced from the said J. C. Kidd

FOR AND ON ACCOUNT OF Complainant having lived separate and apart from the respondent for more than two years next preceding the filing of this cause and without support from him, during which time she has been a resident of Alabama.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that Complainant may resume her maiden name of Doris Abbott when and if she desires to do so.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that neither party to this cause shall again marry, except to each other, until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if an appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall marry, except to each other, during the pendency of such appeal.

It is further ordered that Doris A. Kidd PAY THE COST herein taxed, for which execution may issue.

It is further ordered that Doris A. Kidd and J. C. Kidd, each, be permitted to again contract marriage after sixty days from rendition of this decree, if there be no appeal from same, upon payment of the costs of this suit.
