Kidd died in 1947.

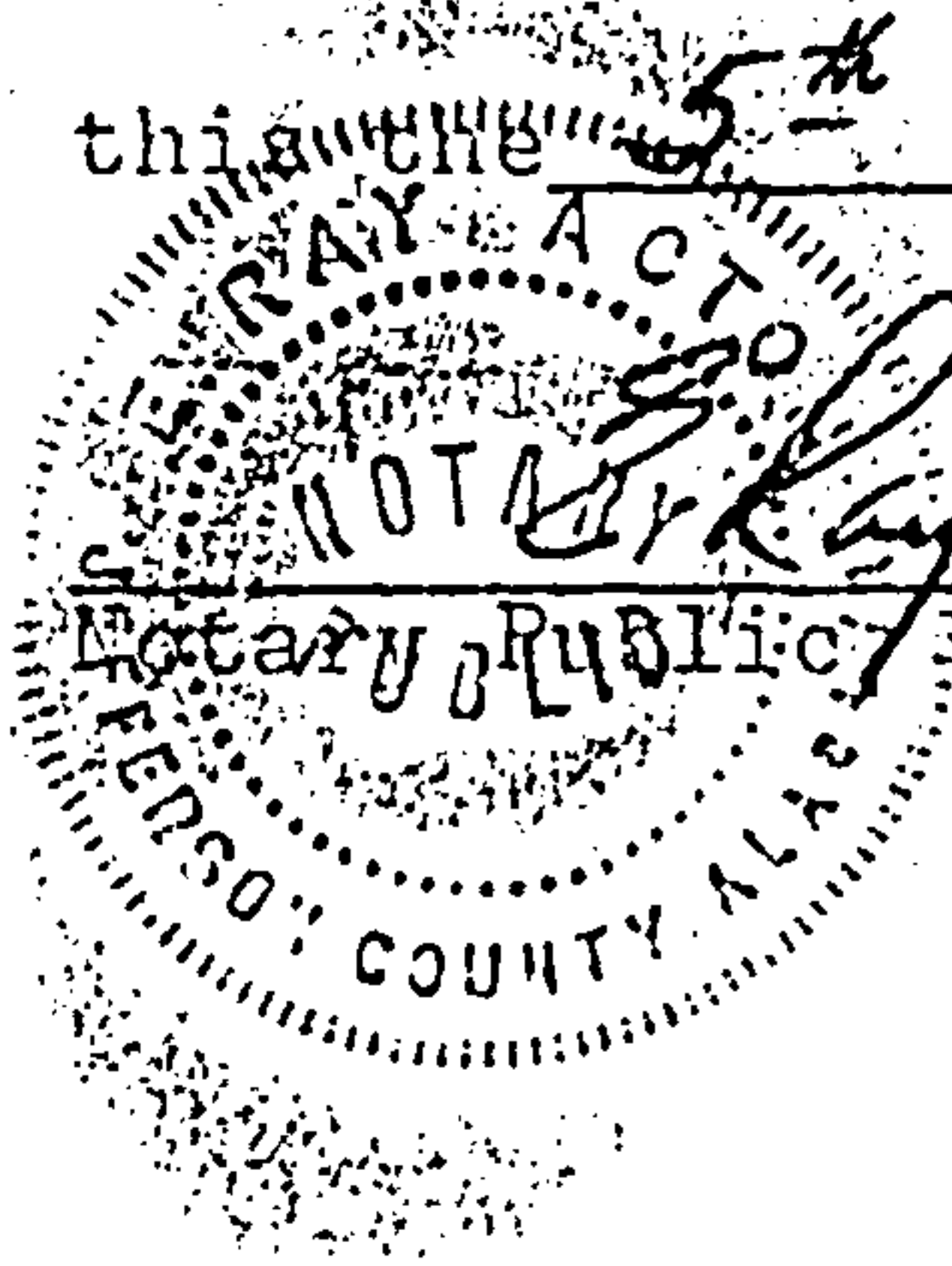
Among other land conveyed in said deed is the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 19, Range 1 West, but the land meant to be conveyed was actually Range 1 East and not Range 1 West.

Said D. W. Kidd and Lilla M. Kidd left surviving as their sole heirs at law and next of kin entitled to share in the distribution of their estate, J. L. Kidd (affiant) and J. C. Kidd, who with their respective wives executed to A. C. Gill a deed conveying the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section ;24, Township 19, Range 1 East, Shelby County, Alabama, which deed is dated August 23, 1947 and is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Deed Book 130 at page 542.
