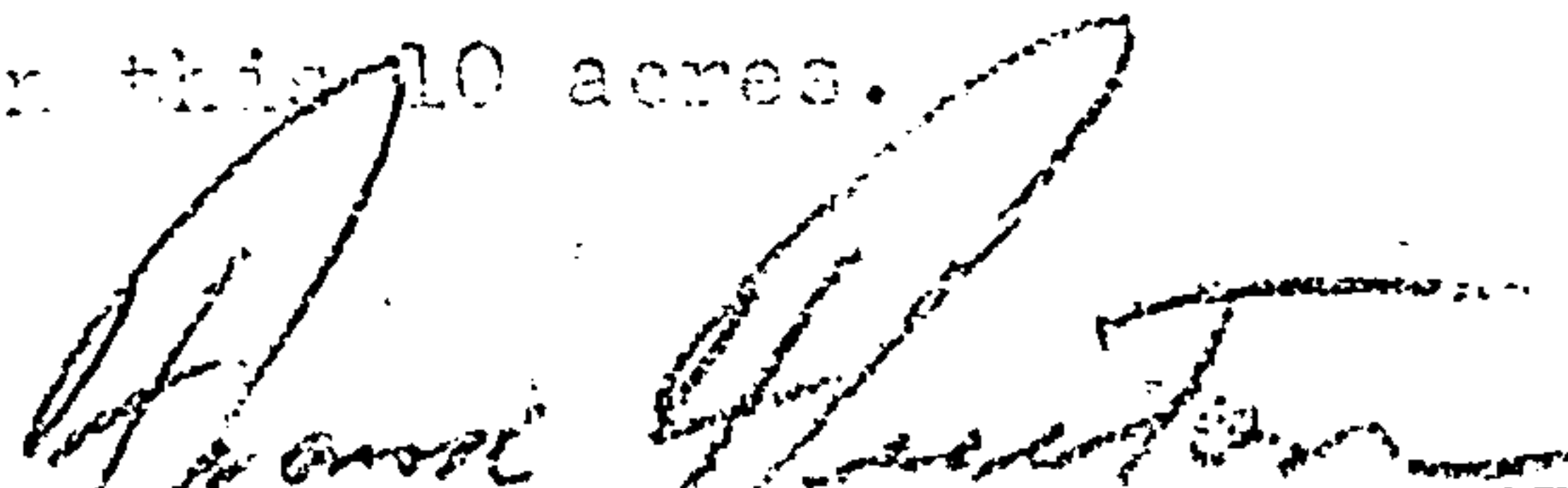


STATE OF ALABAMA

Before the undersigned authority, personally appeared Frank Fulton who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am acquainted with the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 21, Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama. I purchased this 10 acres of land from Newt Neely and wife and procured a deed from them dated July 22, 1940 and which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Deed Book 108 at page 580. I deeded this property to Joe Roper and Georgia Roper and conveyed it by deed to them on August 12, 1941 which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Deed Book 110 at page 388. Mr. and Mrs. Roper immediately went into possession of the land and built a dwelling house on it, and they lived upon it and cultivated parts of it until Joe Roper and his wife separated and he later made her a deed to his interest in the property. After their separation, Georgia Roper remained in possession of the property, living upon it and cultivating parts of it each and every year down to the present time. She has remained in actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, adverse and hostile possession of the same. During all of that time no other party, person, firm or corporation has claimed any interest in this 10 acres.
