do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Paul O.Luck

the following described real estate situated in Shelby ..... County, Ala., to-wit: That certain  
parcel, or tract of land situated in the Northwest Quarter of the South-  
west Quarter of Section 2<sup>4</sup>, Township 21, South, Range 1 West, described as  
commencing at the Southwest corner of said Section 2<sup>4</sup>, and run thence  
North 3 degrees West along the West Section line of said Section 2<sup>4</sup>, for
