the receipt whereof is acknowledged we the said J. C. Galbreath and wife, Margaret
Galbreath

do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. H. Haynes

the following described real estate, situated in Shelby
County, Alabama, to-wit:

An undivided one-fourth interest in and to the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$; the NW $\frac{1}{4}$
of NE $\frac{1}{4}$; all of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ that lies in Shelby County, and
also 5 acres in the NE corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ described as follows:
