Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared W. R. Silcocks, a registered surveyor for the State of Alabama, No. 2054, who being known to me, and being first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows: That he surveyed on April 6, 1955 the following described real estate situated in the Town of Calera, Alabama:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the center line of Montgomery Avenue and the center of the main line track of the Southern Railroad, thence north along the center line of Montgomery Avenue a distance of 499 feet; thence at a right angle left a distance of 40 feet to a point of beginning at an iron pin; thence at a right angle to the right, north along the west line of said avenue a distance of 175 feet; thence at an interior angle of 89 deg. 27 min. left westerly a distance of 150 feet; thence at an interior angle of 90 deg. 33 min. left, a distance of 175 feet; thence at an interior angle of 89 deg. 27 min. left a distance of 150 feet to the point of beginning, said property lying in the City of Calera, Shelby County, Alabama.

That he has examined a tracing of a copy of Dare's survey of the Town of Calera and also a copy of Dunstan's survey of the Town of Calera; that from the study of these maps and the survey which he made, it is his information and belief that the above described property is the same property as the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 10, Lot 11 and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 12, according to Dare's survey of the Town of Calera, Alabama, together with a lot 75 feet by 150 feet which joins the North boundary of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 12 and extends Northerly along Montgomery Avenue 75 feet and westerly and perpendicular to said Montgomery Avenue 150 feet.

Affiant further says that said property, according to his information and belief from a survey of said land and an examination of a copy of Dunstan's Map of the Town of Calera, Alabama, that said above described land is the same land as Lots 6, 7, and 8 in Block 27, according to Dunstan's Map of the Town of Calera, Alabama.
