I went into possession of the land, and had the timber cut from it and later in 1945 on September 27th, I deeded the land back to Mr. Tait. This deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Deed Record 122 at page 52. Mr. Tait immediately went into possession of the land after I executed the deed back to him and built him a little house on it and lived on it some two or three years, or at least until he died.

Since 1940 during the time I have known the land to the present time neither Howard Lloyd, J. W. Lynn or A. R. Brantley or George Huddleston, Jr. have been in possession of said property and during the last 15 years have exercised no acts of ownership over it.
