Before the undersigned authority, personally appeared, L. B. Riddle, who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am acquainted with the following described land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, viz:

$S\frac{1}{2}$ of $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 21, Range 2 West lying East of Montgomery-Birmingham Highway.

Also the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 21 Range 2 West lying East of Montgomery-Birmingham Highway, being Highway No. 31, except 5 acres more or less described as follows:

Beginning on the East right of way boundary of U.S. Highway 31, at a point 678 feet South of the East and West median line of said Section; run thence in a Easterly direction parallel with the East and West median line of said Section 28 to Camp Branch; thence South along Camp Branch 97 feet; thence West and parallel with the East and West median line to said Highway 31; thence in a Northerly direction along said Highway 97 feet more or less to point of beginning.

I once owned this land and had a house on it and tenants on it for eleven years. As a matter of fact I built a dwelling house on the property and was in the actual, open, notorious, continuous, hostile and adverse possession of same claiming to own it and had tenants on it all the while who cultivated portions of it each and every year. During the time I owned said property and subsequent thereto so far as I know or am informed, neither, R. L. Holcombe, Calera Lime Corporation, Coosa Land Company, Inc., C. O. Chambless, Willie L. Chambless, J. O. Anderson, Mary E. Anderson, Twin Oaks Land Company nor Wilson Durden had any possession of this property lying East of Camp Branch or any other portion of said property above described. While I owned the land I had all the land East of Camp Branch along with a portion of that West of Camp Branch under fence and it was fenced up as long as I owned it.
