WITNESSETH, that whereas, the parties of the first part own jointly the real estate hereinafter conveyed, each of said parties owning an undivided one-half interest in said real estate; and whereas, the said John R. Vann, as Receiver of the First National Bank of Sylacauga, Alabama, has been authorized by the Comptroller of the Currency of the United States, and also by the Circuit Court of Talladega County, Alabama, in its decree heretofore made, to join with said Birmingham Trust and Savings Company in selling and conveying said real estate to parties of the second part, for the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars;
