do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Claude Brown, Jr. and wife, Elna L. Brown

the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Ala., to-wit:
A part of Lots 1 and 2 in Block 2 of Nickerson's Survey on Helena Road as recorded
in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Map Book 3, page 116, more
particularly described as follows: Commencing at the SW corner of said Lot No. 1
which said point is on the East margin of Pine Street, and run North along the West
boundary of said Lot No. 1 300 feet for a point of beginning of the land herein
described and conveyed; thence continue Northerly along the West boundary of said
Lot No. 1, 150 feet; thence East and perpendicular to said West boundary of said
Lot 200 feet to the West boundary of Lot No. 3, in Block 2 of said survey; thence


