WHEREAS, to secure the collection of said tax, notice of the lien of the United States, attaching to all the property and rights to property of the said taxpayer on account of said tax indebtedness, was filed with the Probate Judge, Shelby County, Alabama in Tax Book F, Page 272 and Tax Book            for the F, Page 42 and Tax Book F, Page 261, and also with the           , in accordance with the provisions of law applicable thereto.

WHEREAS, the lien of the United States for said tax has attached to certain property described as:  
"PARCEL A" - Beginning at the Northeast corner of NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 11, Township 21, South Range 2 West, thence South along the East line of said NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> to the Southeast corner thereof; thence 58 degrees 26 minutes to the right in a Southwesterly direction a distance of 514.3 feet to the center of that certain road leading from L. T. Bounds' main dwelling house to Columbiana-Saginaw paved road; thence 56 degrees 40 minutes to the left in a Southerly direction a distance of 116.6 feet to a point in the center of said road; thence 6 degrees 09 minutes to the right in a Southwesterly direction along the center of said road a distance of 854.1 feet to the South line of the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Section 11 thence West along the South line of said SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> a distance of 769.0 feet to the Southwest corner thereof; thence North along the West line of SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> OF SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> to the Northwest corner thereof; thence 67 degrees 35 minutes to the right a distance of 626.0 feet; thence 43 degrees 43 minutes to the left a distance of 695.8 feet to a point on the West line of said road leading from L. T. Bounds' main dwelling house to Columbiana-Saginaw paved road; thence 5 degrees 30 minutes to the left and along the West line of said road a distance of 120.0 feet; thence 30 degrees 23 minutes to the left and along the West line of said road a distance of 53.8 feet; thence 23 degrees 45 minutes to the left and along the West line of

WHEREAS, the District Director of Internal Revenue has determined that if the certificate of discharge is issued with respect to the foregoing property, the other property which will remain subject to the lien of the United States has a fair market value at this time of at least double the sum of: (1) the amount of the liability remaining unsatisfied in respect of such tax and (2) the amount of all prior liens upon such property;

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS INSTRUMENT WITNESSETH, That I, George D. Patterson, District Director of Internal Revenue at Birmingham, Alabama, charged by law with the duty of collecting and enforcing the collection of internal revenue taxes due the United States, and charged with the assessment hereinbefore stated, do, pursuant to the provisions of section 6325(b)(1), Internal Revenue Code of 1954, discharge the property heretofore described from the aforesaid tax lien, saving and reserving, however, the force and effect of said tax lien against and upon all other property and/or rights to property to which said lien is attached, wheresoever situated.
