I purchased the property hereinafter described from J. W. Bramblett, July 28, 1941:

A parcel of land known as the Britton lot and the Boyd lot more fully described as follows: Beginning 20 yds South of the Northwest corner of the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> running South 35 yards; along Section line; thence East 70 yards; thence North 35 yards; thence West 70 yards to point of commencement with all improvements thereon located in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 22 Township 20 Range 3 West. Situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

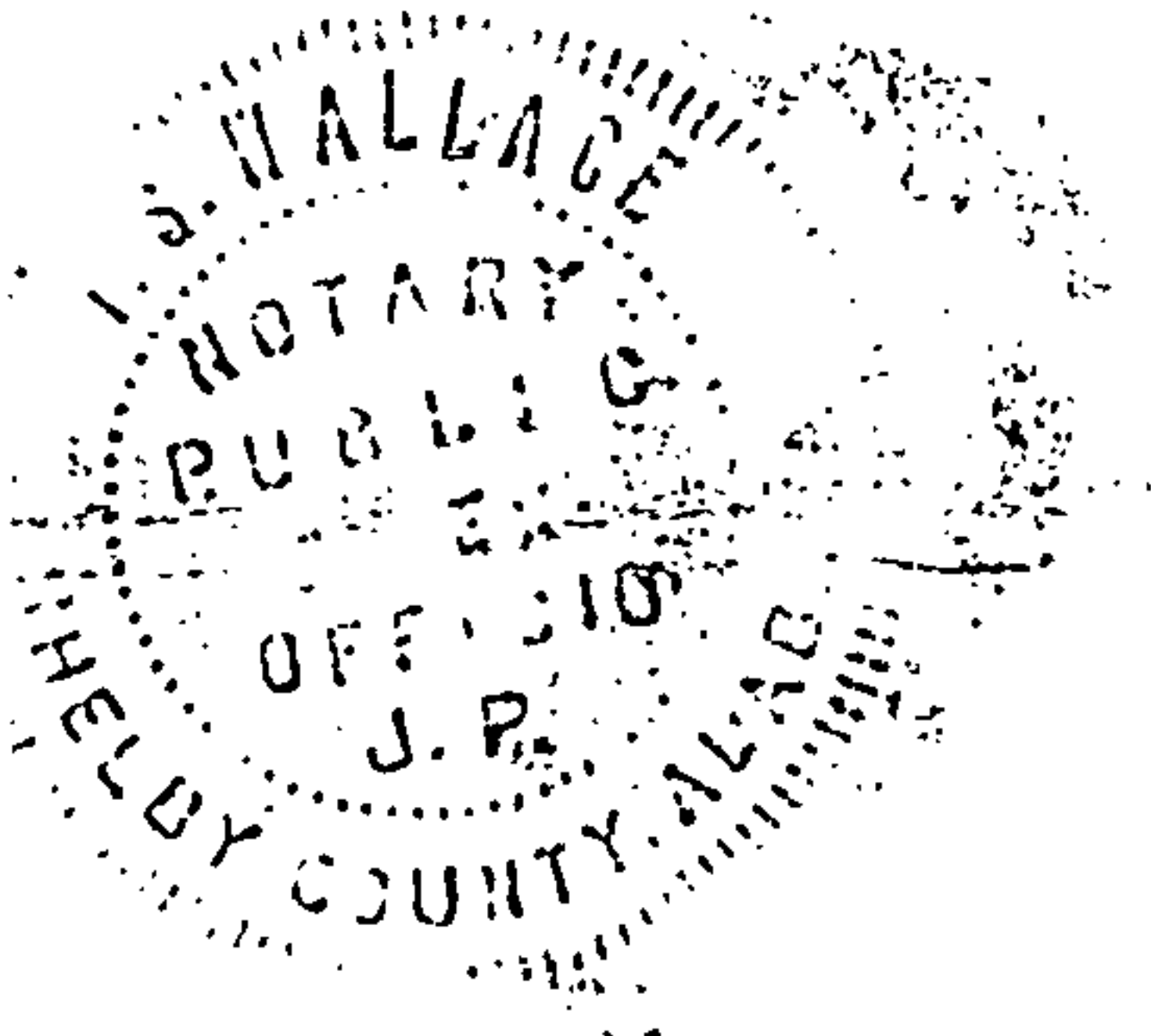
I lived on the above described property from the date purchased until 1952 and was at all times in peaceful possession. I was not molested by anyone; no other person has asserted in any way ownership or any interest in the property; no one claimed any title to the property other than myself; I knew of no title adverse to my own; my possession was adverse, open, hostile and notorious to the whole world.

My grantor, J. W. Bramblett, resided on the property above described, as sole owner, from 1922 until 1941. His possession was peaceful, open, and notorious. I know of no claim of title adverse to J. W. Bramblett's during the period of Mr. Bramblett's ownership.
