



Scott, the following described real estate situate in the County of Shelby, State of Alabama, to-wit:

All of Blocks Nos. 1, 9, and 15 according to the survey and map made by H. W. Cannon, a registered surveyor, of a part of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 20, South, Range 3 West, and situated West of Buck Creek, and which is more accurately described in said map recorded in Map Book 3, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and designated as Alabaster Gardens Subdivision.


