

MORTGAGE RELEASE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That whereas United Cement Company, Inc., a corporation, executed a certain mortgage to the undersigned, W. R. Lindbloom, on the 23rd day of August, 1954, which mortgage was recorded in Mortgage Book 239 Page 506 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama,

WHEREAS, said United Cement Company, Inc., a corporation desires to pay the sum of One Dollar to said W. R. Lindbloom and to have the land described below released from said mortgage and said W. R. Lindbloom desires to accept said One Dollar and to release said land from said mortgage;

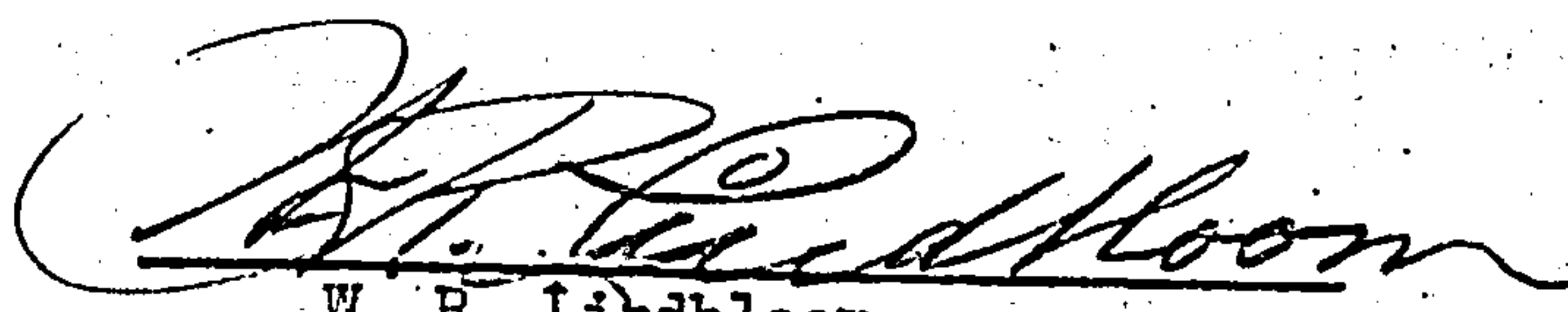
NOW, THEREOFRE, the undersigned, W. R. Lindbloom, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar being paid to said W. R. Lindbloom in hand paid by the said United Cement Company, Inc., a corporation, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby release, remise and quit claim unto United Cement Company, Inc., a corporation, all the right, title and interest acquired under said mortgage in and to that part of the premises conveyed therein, and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a pipe on the east boundary line of Section 6, Township 24, North, Range 13 East and on the north margin of an old road and 3144.4 feet north of the southeast corner of said Section 6; thence south, 03 degrees 03 minutes west, 123.0 feet with the east line of said Section 6 to a pipe; thence south, 85 degrees 38 minutes west, 1429.5 feet to a pipe by a line fence; thence northly with said line fence 101.0 feet to the north margin of said old road; thence north, 79 degrees 20 minutes east along the north margin of said old road 200.0 feet; thence north, 85 degrees 38 minutes east along the north margin of said old road 1220 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; containing 3.99 acres and lying in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 24 North, Range 13 East, Shelby County, Alabama.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said United Cement Company, Inc., a corporation, its successors and assigns forever.

It is understood and agreed that this release shall not in any way impair or affect the right of the said mortgagee to hold the remainder of the premises conveyed in said mortgage and not hereby released as security for that part of the mortgage indebtedness remaining unpaid on said mortgage.

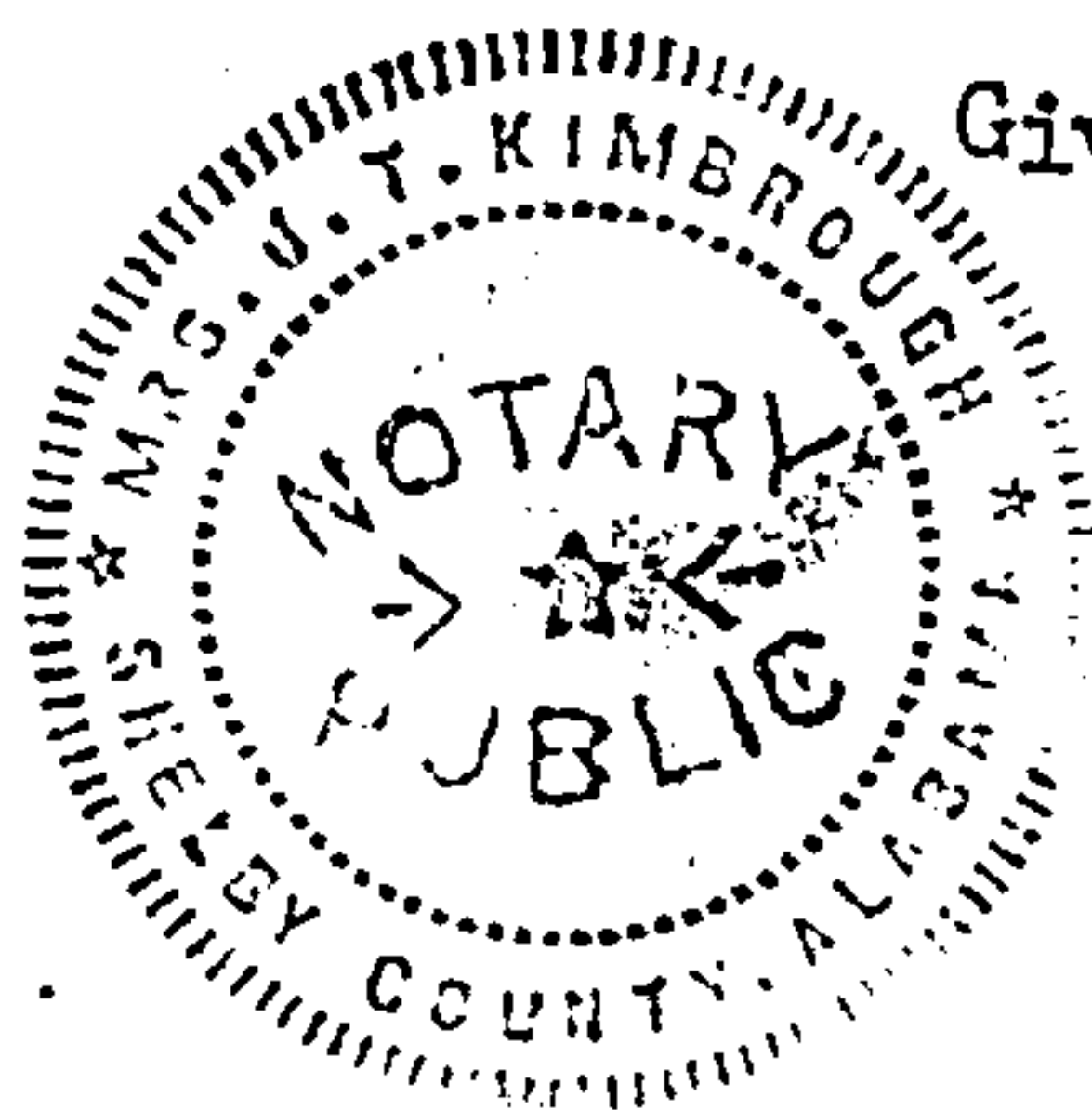
