


## WARRANTY DEED—TITLE GUARANTEE &amp; TRUST CO., BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA

 the receipt whereof is acknowledged we the said L. E. Cox and wife, Ailene Cox  
 do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Andrew C. Cox and wife, Annie Ruth Cox,  
 the following described real estate, situated in SHELBY  
 County, Alabama, to-wit:



Commence at the SE corner of the South 1/2 of the SE, Section 11, Township 18, Range 1, East. From said corner go South 87° 25' West 660 ft.; thence North 4° West 660 ft.; thence South 87° 25' West 660 ft.; thence North 4° West 215 ft.; thence South 87° 15' West 611.5 ft.; thence in a Northwesterly direction 41° 30' to the right 219 ft. to the county road; thence Northeasterly along county road 310.5 ft. until it intersects quarter section quarter section; thence North 87° 25' East 1965 ft.; thence South 4° East 1300.7 ft. to point of beginning.
