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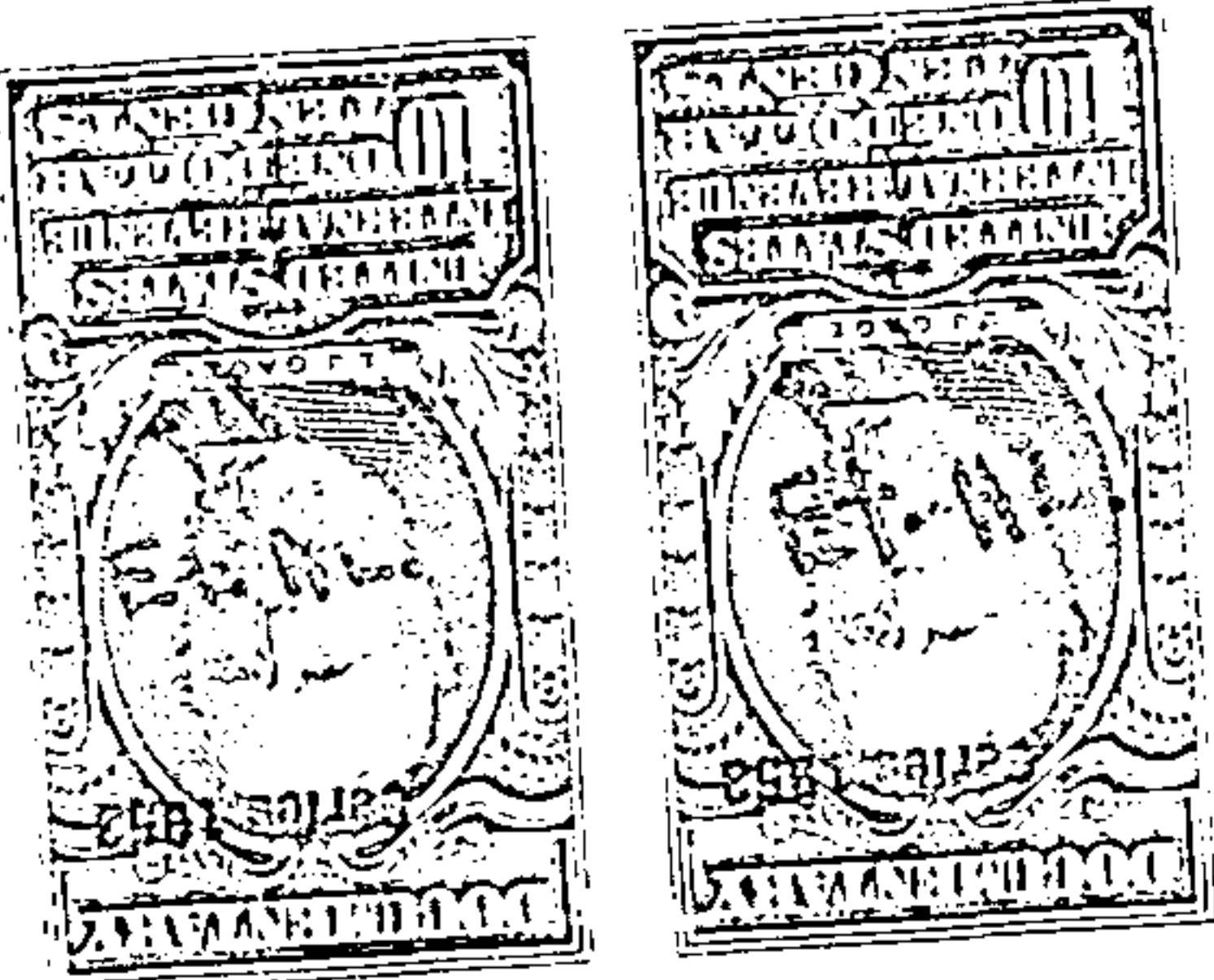

Robinson, deceased, who departed this life intestate on June 29, 1948, there being no administration on said Estate, none being necessary since said Estate owed no debts, PARTY OF THE FIRST PART; and O.C. Farris, PARTY OF THE SECOND PART,

WITNESSETH: THAT the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and NO/100 Dollars in hand paid to them by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained and sold and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate situate, lying, and being in the Town of Calera, in the County of Shelby, in the State of Alabama, to-wit:

A lot or parcel of land in the Town of Calera, Alabama, commencing at a point on the East side of Montgomery Avenue 250 feet South of R.C. Scoggins' Southwest corner at an iron stob, being the Southwest corner of the lot deeded to S.M. Tomlin, and running thence South with said Montgomery Avenue 75 feet; run thence East to the right of way of the South and North Alabama Railroad Company, now the Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company; run thence North parallel with said South and North Railroad Company right of way now the Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company's right of way for a distance of 75 feet; run thence West to the Montgomery Avenue to the point of commencement, it being a part of the land described



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as Lots Nos 2 and 3 of the Map of Calera, Alabama, drawn by the South and North Alabama Railroad Company, showing the subdivisions of land between the said South and North Alabama Railroad Company, Jesse Kelley, and others. Farris, the party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

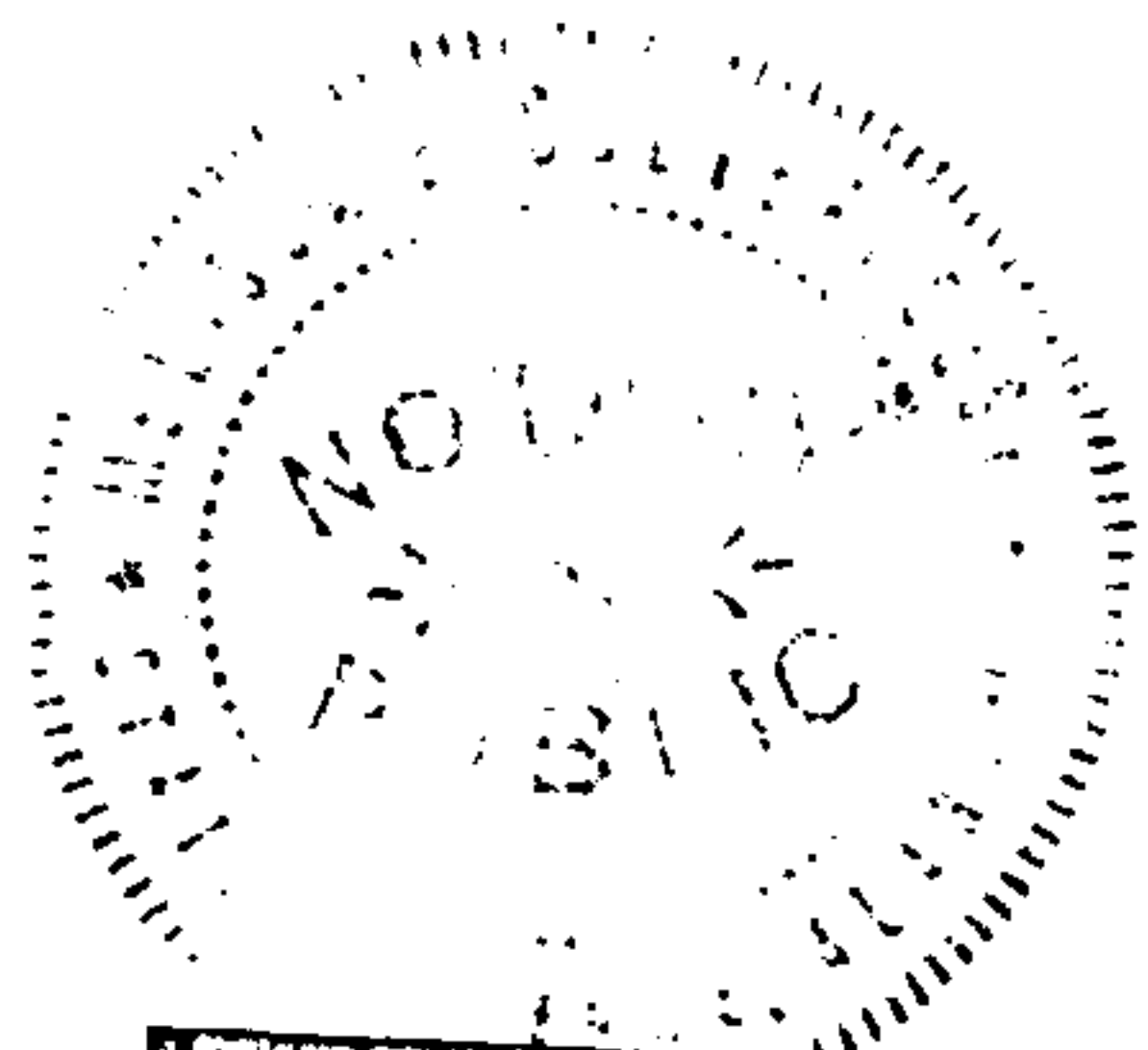
