"My name is Charley Glass. I live upon and occupy the following described parcel of land, situated in the town of Calera, Alabama, viz:

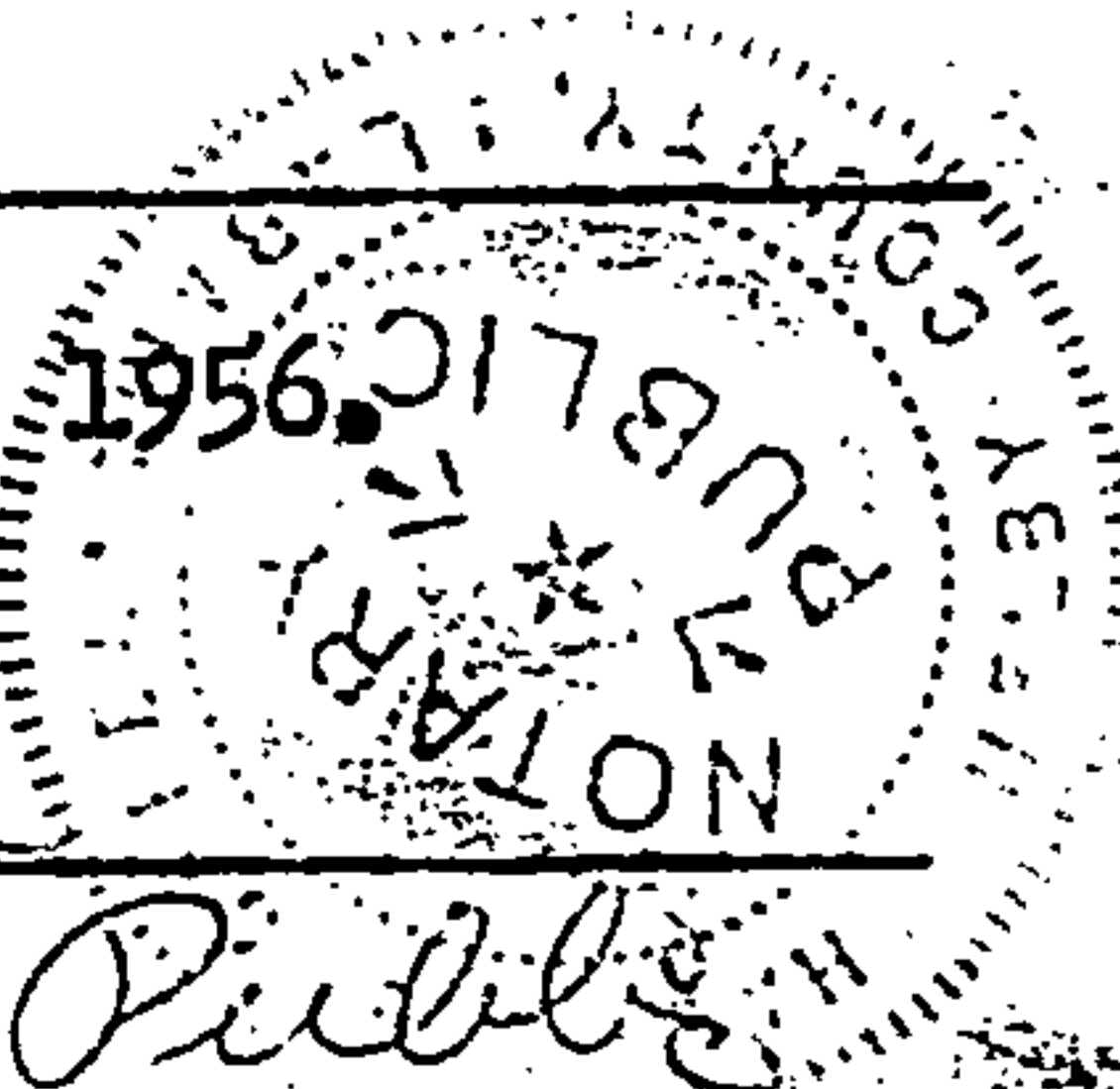
