My name is Charley Glass. I live upon and occupy the following described parcel of land, situated in the town of Calera, Alabama, viz:

Begin at the point of intersection of the eastern boundary of that certain road or street which rims in a northerly and southerly direction along the western boundary of the Charley Glass and Sadie Scoggins lots, and the southern boundary of Fulton Street; from said point of intersection, run in an easterly direction, along the said southern boundary of Fulton Street, a distance of 92 feet, to the northwest corner of the lot now owned and occupied by Wester Glass; thence, run in a southerly direction, along the western boundary of said Waster Glass lot, and, also, along the western boundary of the lot now owned and occupied by Ollie Glass, a distance of 185.6 feet, to the southwest corner of the said Ollie Glass lot; thence, run in a westerly stire direction, along the rith-of-way of the Southern Railroad, a distance of 21.4 feet, to the southeast corner of Sadie Scoggin's lot; thence, in a northerly direction, along the eastern boundary of Sadie Scoggin's lot, 90 feet, to the northeast corner of said Sadie Scoggins lot; thence, westerly, along the northern boundary of said Sadie Scoggins lot, 69.6 feet, to the eastern boundary of the road or street first above mentioned; thence, in a northerly direction, along said eastern boundary of said road or street, toxxit 96 feet, to the point of beginning, said parcel being and consisting of parts of lots six and seven of block ten, according to J. H. Dunstan's survey and plat of the town of Calera, Alabama".
