In my deed to the land the mineral rights were reserved and consequently I do not own the mineral rights.

I assessed the property for taxes each and every year and paid taxes on it.

This land was entered by James W. Acton, and patent was issued which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

My father, Isaac M. Gilbert, purchased this land from R. M. Acton on the 7th of January, 1908, and this deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 40, at page 432.

On the 28th day of March, 1924, the sole heirs at law and next of kind of said Isaac M. Gilbert deeded the property to Ophelia Gardner who is one of the Isaac M. Gilbert children, and the grantors and the grantee were the sole heirs at law and next of kin of said Isaac M. Gilbert at the time said deed was executed.
