KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned George L. Martin and wife, Rose J. Martin, hereby release the following land from operation of that certain mortgage dated October 7, 1955, and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Mortgage Book 240, at page 504, in which Natt C. Smith and wife, Blanche C. Smith are mortgagors, and George L. Martin and wife, Rose J. Martin are mortgagees, namely:

From the Southwest corner of the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 2 West run North along the West boundary of the said Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 2 West 648.95 feet; thence turn an angle of 91 degrees 33 minutes to the right and run for a distance of 747.6 feet to a point on the East right of way of the Louisville and Nashville Railroad for the point of beginning of the tract of land herein conveyed; thence turn an angle of 81 degrees 07 minutes to the right and run along the East right of way of the Louisville and Nashville Railroad a distance of 276.11 feet; thence turn an angle of 81 degrees 07 minutes to the left and run 1554.0 feet, more or less, to a point on the West right of way of U. S. 31 Highway; thence turn an angle of 117 degrees 40 minutes to the left and run along the West right of way of U. S. 31 Highway for 150.23 feet; thence turn an angle of 5 degrees 31 minutes to the right and run along the West right of way of U. S. 31 Highway for 150.84 feet; thence turn an angle of 67 degrees 51 minutes to the left and run for a distance of 1469.74 feet to the point of beginning. This tract of land being a part of the N 1/2 of SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama, and containing 10 acres.

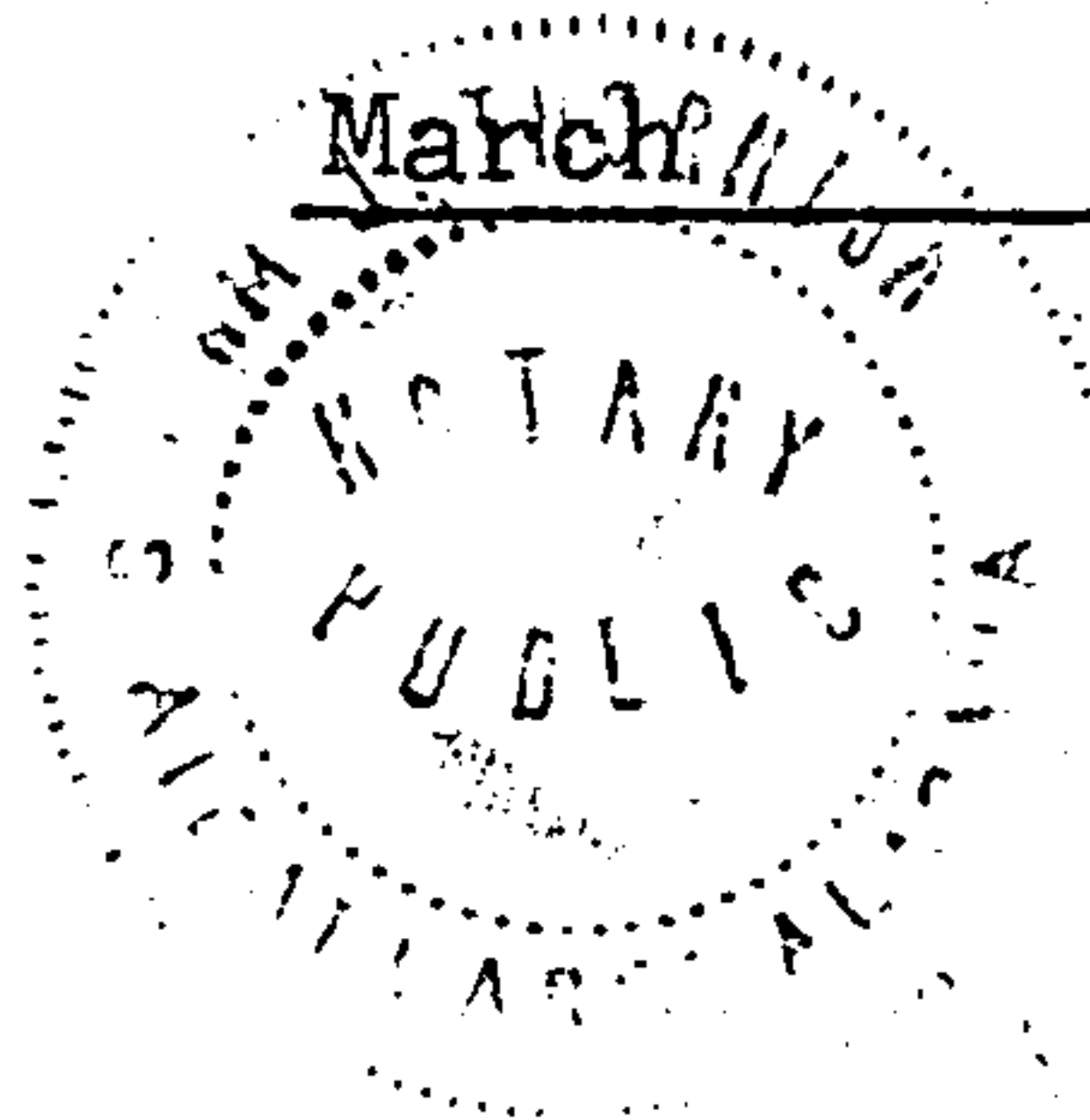
