That certain parcel of land situated in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 20, Township 22, South, Range 2 West, in Shelby County, Alabama, and described as commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 20, Township 22, South, Range 2 West, and run thence South 86 degrees and 31 minutes West a distance of 1393.4 feet to a point on Freeman's Base Line; run thence North 30 degrees West for a distance of 630.5 feet; run thence North 47 degrees and 38 minutes West, a distance of 300 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern margin of the Spring Creek Public Road for a point of beginning of the lot herein described and conveyed: Run thence North 11 degrees and 10 minutes West, a distance of 281.3 feet to an iron pin; run thence North 60 degrees and 20 minutes East a distance of 170.3 feet to an iron pin; run thence North 1 degree and 30 minutes West, a distance of 447.5 feet to an iron pin; run thence South 83 degrees and 50 minutes West a distance of 463 feet to an iron pin; run thence South 3 degrees and 57 minutes East for a distance of 312.5 feet to a stone column; run thence South 37 degrees and 59 minutes East a distance of 299 feet to an iron pin; run thence South 58 degrees and 23 minutes East, a distance of 205.3 feet to point of beginning, and containing 4 acres, more or less.
