That the parties of the first part, in consideration of One Dollars and the said Harper C. Reeves agreeing to construct a storm sewer under the right of way the same size as that now located under said Louisville and Nashville Railroad tracts adjacent to the right of way being granted herein, paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the part of the second part, his successors, heirs and assigns forever, a right of way over a certain strip of land described as follows:

A 15 foot right of way, the center line of which begins on the east line of Helena-Acton public road at a point 7½ feet north of the north right of way of the Main line of the L & N Railroad, which roadway easement herein granted runs in an easterly direction with the center line of said roadway being parallel to and 7½ feet north of said north right of way of said L & N Railroad and said roadway extends in an easterly direction until the same intersects with the west line of property formerly known as Connors Steel Company property, being described in Deed Book 123 Page 113 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. Said right of way being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Said strip of land is to be used by said party of the second part, his successors, heirs and assigns as a roadway and as a means of ingress and egress to and from the above mentioned Connors Steel Company lot. It is also understood and Agreed that this Road is to be open to the public at all times
