Know all men by these presents, That in consideration of
FIFTY (\$50.00) DOLLARS
to the undersigned grantor s, Jewell Hawkins and wife, Virginia Hawkins ,
in hand paid by James Alexander

the receipt whereof is acknowledged we the said Jewell Hawkins and wife, Virginia
Hawkins do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
James Alexander

the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

The east 108.9 feet of Lot Number 1, of Block "B", according to K. B. Nickerson's
Addition to Alabaster, Alabama, situated in section 1, township 21, range 3 west,
said lot being further described as beginning at the southeast corner of Lot Number
1, in Block "B" of said Nickerson's Addition to Alabaster, and run thence north 3
degrees and 23 minutes west, 200 feet; thence, run south 87 degrees and 55 minutes
west, a distance of 108.9 feet; thence, run south 3 degrees and 23 minutes east,
200 feet; thence, run north 87 degrees and 45 minutes east, a distance of 108.9
feet, to the point of beginning.

Except from the above, however, all that portion of the same heretofore
conveyed under that certain right-of-way deed executed by the grantors herein,
on May 18, 1954, to Shelby County, which said deed is recorded in Deed Book 166,

heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.
