To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS William Yuvacatto, of Shelby County,

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Tuscaloosa,

whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

William Yuvacatto,

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the first half of the South East quarter, and the East half of the North East quarter of Section four, in Township nineteen of Range two East, in the District of lands Subject to Sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, Containing one hundred and eighty acres, and forty-four hundredths of an acre.

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said William Yuvacatto.

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said William Yuvacatto,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said William Yuvacatto,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
