the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the South East quarter, and the East half of the North East quarter of Section 16, in Township nineteen of Range two East, in the District of land Subject to Sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing one hundred and thirty acres, and forty four hundredths of an acre.

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *William Hurrett*

and to his heirs and assigns forever.

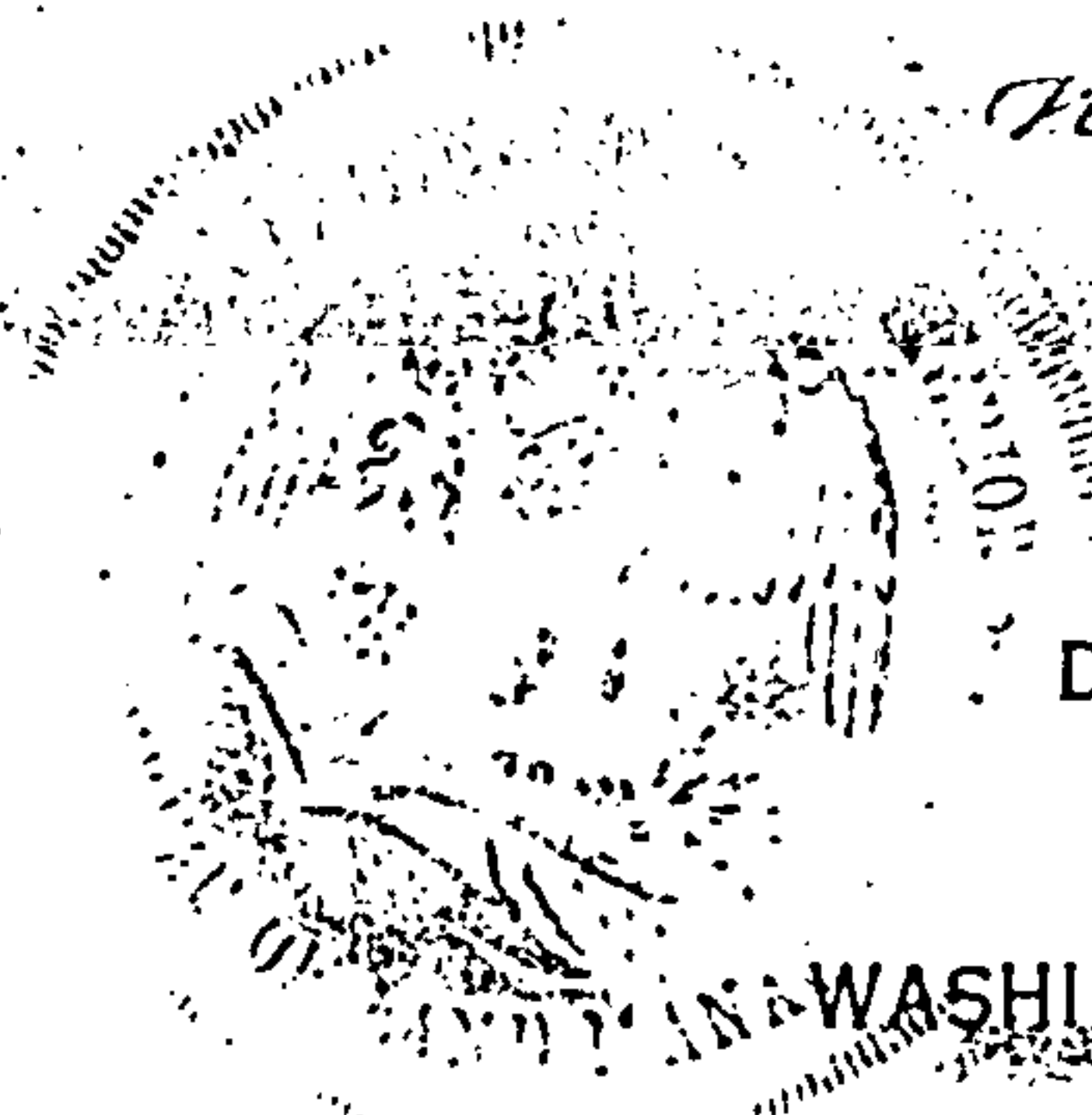
