Before me, Martha B. Joiner, the undersigned authority in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared Fermon Foster, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is Fermon Foster. I am 49 years of age and have lived within 1 1/2 miles of the following described property all of my life and I am well familiar with it and the persons in possession of it. Said land being described as follows:

E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 21, Range 1 West,
Shelby County, Alabama.

I recall when Walter Aldridge, who is one and the same person as Walter M. Aldridge and W. M. Aldridge, entered said land in 1926, as shown by patent recorded in Deed Book 104 Page 7 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. He built a little house on a portion of it and cut telephone poles from it and it is my recollection he sold part of the timber for saw timber during the time he owned the land. Walter Aldridge was in the actual possession of said land from the time he patented the same until he sold the same to A. B. Bristow on December 24, 1937, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 100 Page 576 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. The said A. B. Bristow went into immediate possession of the land and marked the lines and cut the timber off the same from time to time during the time he owned it. In fact, I have cut poles from said land two times--one time in 1938 and again in 1942.

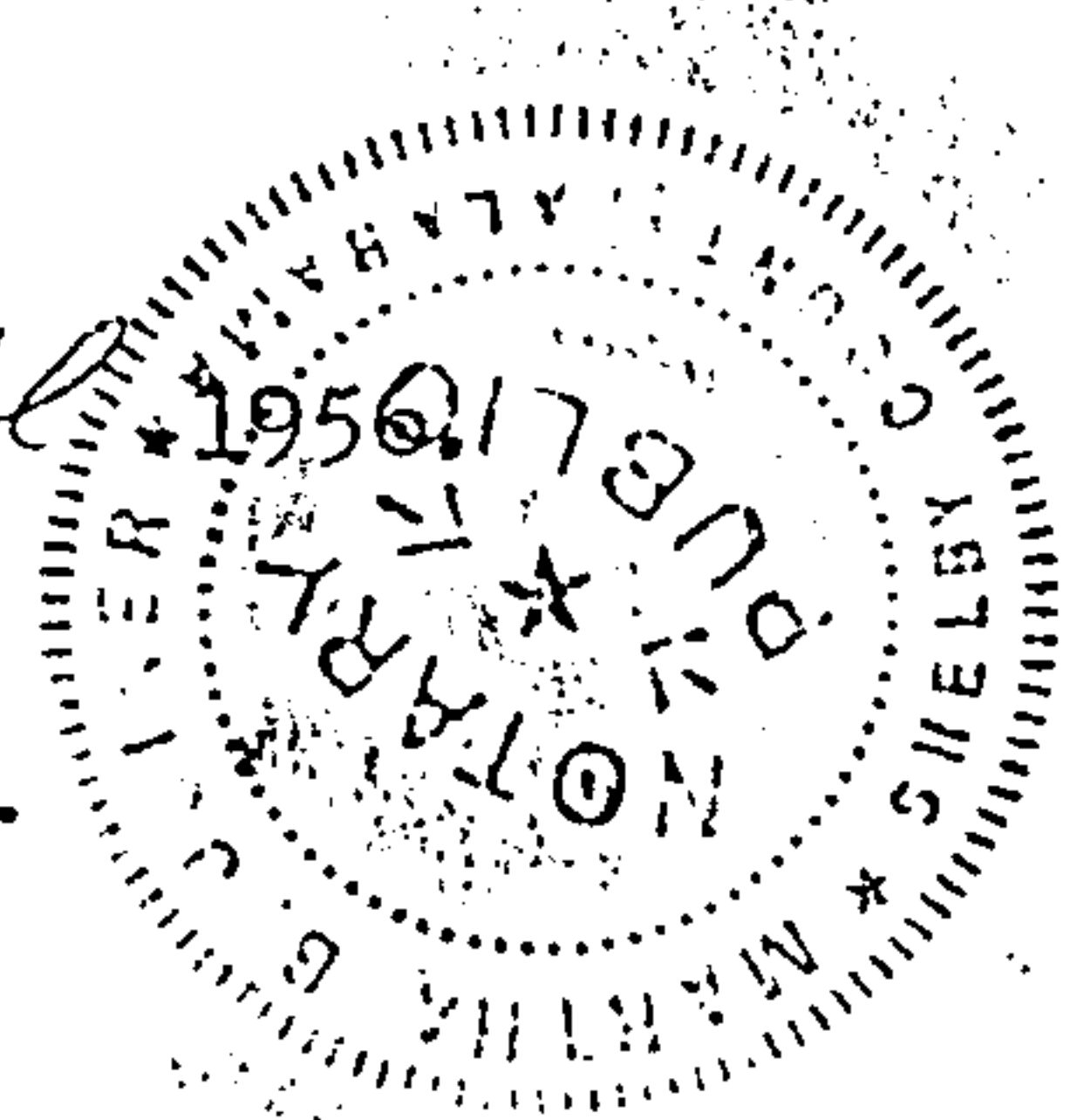
