I

It is my will and I direct that my executrix hereinafter named, as soon after my death as convenient pay all debts owing by me at the time of my death including expenses of my funeral and the erection of a suitable monument over my grave.

II

I hereby give, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife, Euniece V. Smith all property of which I may die seized or possessed or to which I may have a right at law or in equity, whether real, personal or mixed, to have and to hold and to enjoy during her lifetime with full power to sell and convey a fee simple title thereto and to use the proceeds therefrom as she sees fit, but at her death should there be any of my property remaining or proceeds of my property, such remaining property, I hereby give, devise and bequeath to my beloved sister, Mrs. Anna Wynn and her heirs in fee simple.

III

I hereby nominate, appoint and constitute the said Euniece V. Smith as my executrix under this will and grant her full power to sell and dispose of any part of my property for the purpose of paying debts or maintaining herself or for re-investment and hereby direct that she not be required to give bond, make inventory or any report to any court whatsoever for her acts as such executrix.
