My name is G. L. Chamberlin. I am 71 years of age and am the same person to whom May M. Whilden and others made a deed on September 29, 1908, which deed is recorded in Deed Book 41 Page 386 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and which deed conveyed to me the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 21, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama. As the deed indicates, most of the persons making said deed acknowledged it out of the State of Alabama, except for P. T. Whilden and wife, May M. Whilden, and their signatures were acknowledged before a Notary Public in Jefferson County, Alabama. It is my recollection that said land was not the homestead of May M. Whilden or any of the other persons at the time said deed was made.

Affiant further says on February 9, 1910, when he made a deed to G. F. Peter conveying the above described land, that he was an unmarried man.
