My mother was Mollie Jenkins. I am now 30 years of age and my mother died when I was about two years of age. She had two children and two children only, one of them being myself, an adopted daughter, and Kathleen Glass Hill, whose husband is Walter Hill.

Said Kathleen Glass Hill and her husband, Walter Hill, executed a deed to me in which they conveyed the following property, namely:

Commence at the Southwest corner of the Carl Smith Lot and run East along South boundary of said lot 377 feet to West boundary of Birmingham-Montgomery Highway right of way: thence South 13 deg West along said right of way 389 feet; thence West 285 feet; thence North 2 deg West 380 feet to mint of beginning. Excepting right of way of New Birmingham Montgomery Highway. Mineral rights excepted. Said lot being a part of the SW1 of NW1 of Section 25, Township 20 South, Range 3 West. Situated in Shelby County, Albama.

The above deed is dated January 20, 1933, and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 84, at page 526. I originally went under the name of Peachie Jenkins.

My mother, Mollie Jenkins, was in possession of the lot above described at the time of her death and was living on it as a homeplace when she died, and I have been in the actual possession of it and have been living on it all the while down to the present time.

My husband's name is Frank E. Dunnaway.
