W.C. Grant July 12, 1825

The United States of America.

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas the said Shelby County

had deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Washington, D.C.,

whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Shelby County

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 31st of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the said half of the North East quarter of Section Twenty Nine of Township No. 10 North of Range No. 10 East of the

Third Principal Meridian in the State of Alabama, containing five acres, more or less, as shown by the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been

chartered by the said Shelby County

and the said Shelby County, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several

acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Shelby County

the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appur-

tenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Shelby County

and his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, James H. Smith, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto

affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the 12th day of July, 1825, in the year of our

Lord, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-fifth, and of the Independence of the United States the

forty-fifth.
