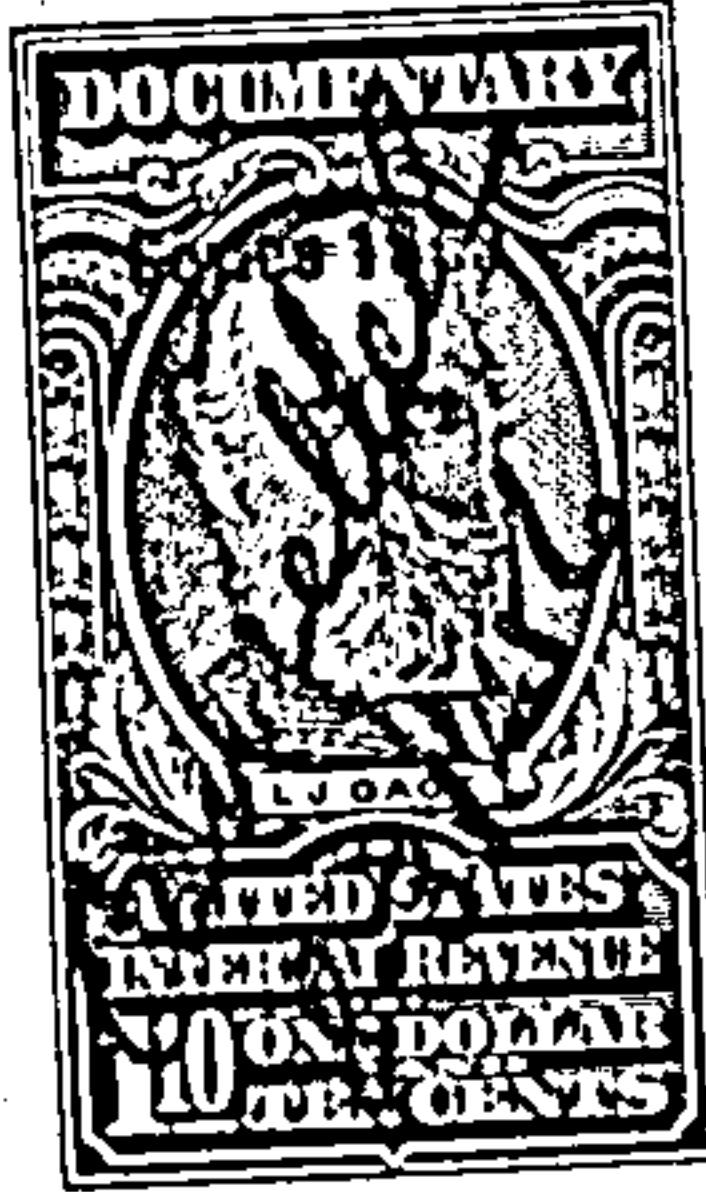

Know all men by these presents, That in consideration of ONE HUNDRED and NO/100, and other valuable considerations, DOLLARS to the undersigned grantor S., Elvie Parker and wife, Laura Lee Parker, in hand paid by Eugene M. McDonald and wife, Lilla F. McDonald,

the receipt whereof is acknowledged we the said Elvie Parker and wife, Laura Lee Parker, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Eugene M. McDonald and wife, Lilla F. McDonald,

the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit: That certain parcel of land situated in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 11, Township 18, Range 1 East, described as commencing at the Northeast corner of said Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 11, and run thence West along the North boundary of said forty acres for a distance of 662 feet, more or less, to the West boundary line of the Leeds-Vincent paved Highway, being Highway No. 21; run thence in a Southeasterly direction along the West right of way line of said paved Highway for a distance of 210 feet to the point of beginning of the lot herein described and conveyed: Run thence West 420 feet; run thence in a Southeasterly direction for a distance of 210 feet; run thence East and parallel with the North line of said parcel of land for a distance of 420 feet to the West right of way line of said paved Highway; run thence in a Northwesterly direction along the West right of way line of said paved Highway for a distance of 210 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 2 acres, more or less, and all situated in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 11, Township 18, Range 1 East.
