Affiant further says that she is well acquainted with the following described land situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

North half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 2, Township 24, Range 15, East.

That this property was purchased together with other property by Lula Johnson from J. J. Lovett in 1925 as shown by deed recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Deed Book 78, page 451.

That at the time this land was purchased by affiant's mother, affiant's mother and affiant's uncles and aunts took possession of the property and lived on such property for several years. After the parties named above moved from the land, the same sold for taxes and was purchased by A. B. Bristow at a tax sale, a deed of which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in tax sale record 13, page 138.

Affiant further says that she has never heard the title of Lula Johnson questioned in any except the title acquired by A. B. Bristow through the tax sale mentioned above.
