Before the undersigned authority personally appeared C. E. Jones, who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am the Grantee in that certain deed executed by Dean Edwards and others to me, dated August 9, 1938, and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 111, at page 77.

The property described in said deed is as follows:

The SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34; the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 21, Range 3 West, and all that part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 22, Range 3 West, lying North of the Columbiana-Tuscaloosa public road, except church lot, as well as other property.

I immediately, upon the execution of said deed, went into possession of said property, living upon it, and cultivating portions of it, built a house on it, and lived on it most of the time, but when I was away I had it in the hands of tenants who cultivated portions of it each and every year, until I deeded it to J. C. Sargeant, Jr. in 1945, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Deed Book 121, at page 79.

From the time I purchased the land until I deeded it to Sargeant as aforesaid, I had the actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, adverse, hostile possession of the property, claiming to own it, either living upon it or having tenants upon it, and having portions of it cultivated each and every year.
