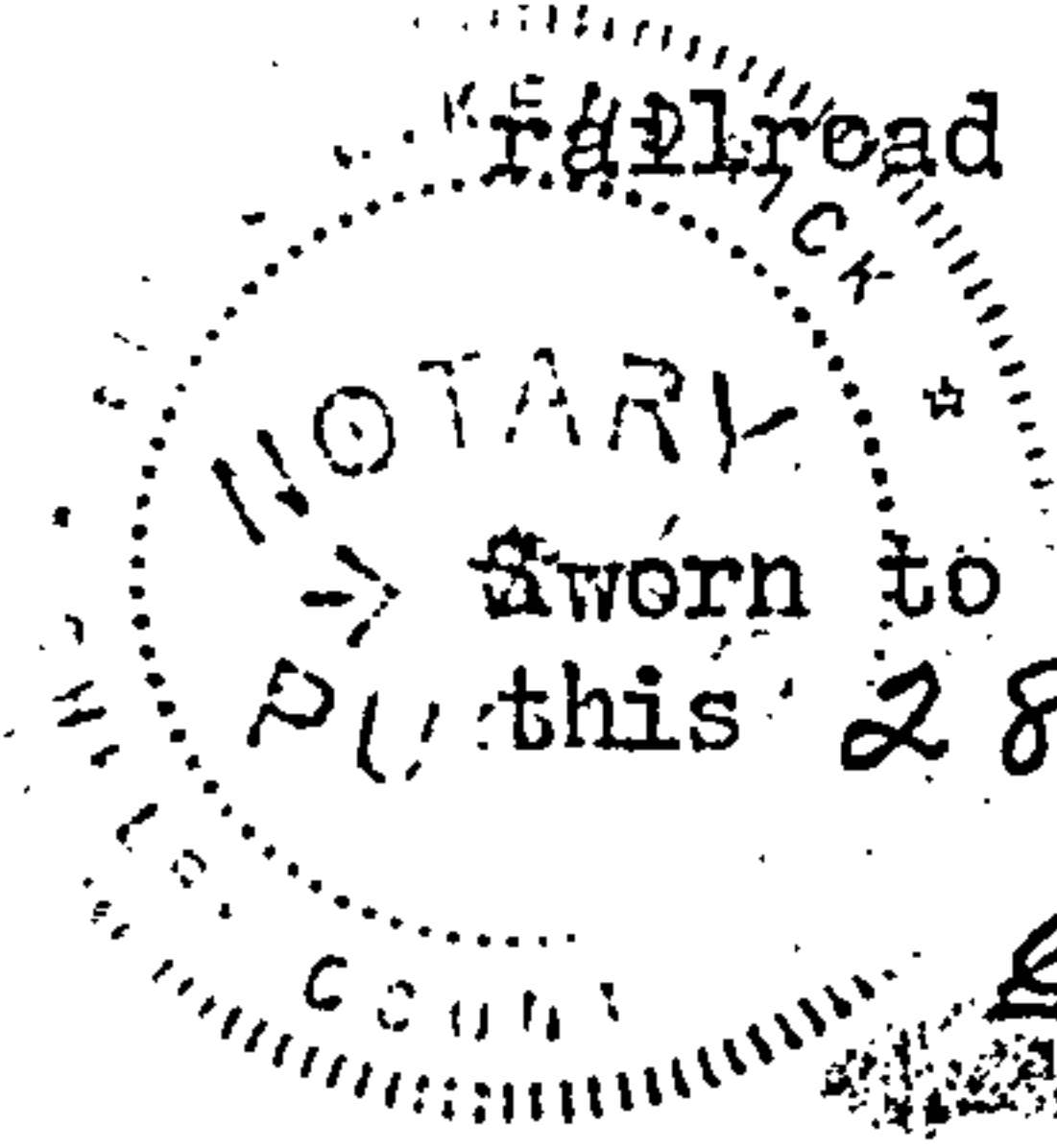
My name is R. E. Whaley. I am the present owner of the following described land:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, Township 21, Range 3 West;  
NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and all NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  west of Elyton Road in Section 21,  
Township 21, Range 3 West;  
Shelby County, Alabama.

On August 9, 1947, I gave the State of Alabama a Material Option with the right to remove gravel from said land situated in said Section 17 for the use in construction of road project known as Montevallo-Siluria road, from the date of the execution of said option to the termination of the project. On October 14, 1952, I gave the State of Alabama a Material Option with the right to remove sand clay from said land situated in said Section 21 for the use in construction of road project SACP 462-A, Dogwood-Maylene road, from the date of the execution of said option to the termination of the project. On October 27, 1952, I gave the State of Alabama a Material Option with the right to remove clay gravel from NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 17 for the use in construction of said project SACP 462-A, Dogwood-Maylene road, from date of execution of said option to the termination of the project. On March 26, 1953, I gave the State of Alabama a Material Option with the right to remove clay gravel for the use in construction of road project SACP 460-A, Helena-Maylene road, from the date of the execution of said option to the termination of the project. Affiant further says that said roads have been paved for several years and the State of Alabama has no further rights or interest in said land.

Affiant further says that he was well acquainted with George F. Peter and he knows he died in the year 1950.

Affiant further says that with reference to a right of way deed in which John A. Monagas or R. E. Whaley appear as the grantors and Shelby County as the grantee, which is dated April 2, 1952, and recorded in Deed Book 152 Page 330 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, that John A. Monagas owns a lot in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 21, but the same is located west of the railroad and east of the Montevallo-Helena paved road.
