Before me Carl G. Harrison, the undersigned authority in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared L.C. Walker, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth deposes and says:

My name is James E. Naish. I am 73 years of age and have lived in Shelby County, Alabama for the past 73 years and have all along been well acquainted with the people in possession and familiar with the land hereinafter described, as follows:

A part of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, more particularly described as follows: Begin at a point where the east boundary line of said Section 17 intersects the north right of way line of Saginaw Short Cut Highway and run in a westerly direction along north right of way line of said highway to a point which is 165 feet west of said Section line; thence north 234 feet; thence easterly direction and parallel with north right of way line of said highway a distance of 165 feet, more or less, to the east line of said Section; thence in a southerly direction along east line of said Section a distance of 234 feet to point of beginning; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant further says that he is one and the same person as Jimmie Naish who purchased the above described property, along with other land from Clarence Burgin and others on January 15, 1914, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 56, Page 22 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and that grantors have owned no interest in said land since. Affiant further says that he was familiar with the narrow gauge railway which ran from the Longview Lime Works across a portion of the above described forty and affiant says that said tract right of way ran across the East 50 feet of above said lot, but that said tract was abandoned and has not been used for the past 65 or 70 years and affiant has held said land in said 40 acres adverse to all the world from time he purchased it in 1914 to time he sold said lot to James L. Harris and Ruth N. Harris in 1956.

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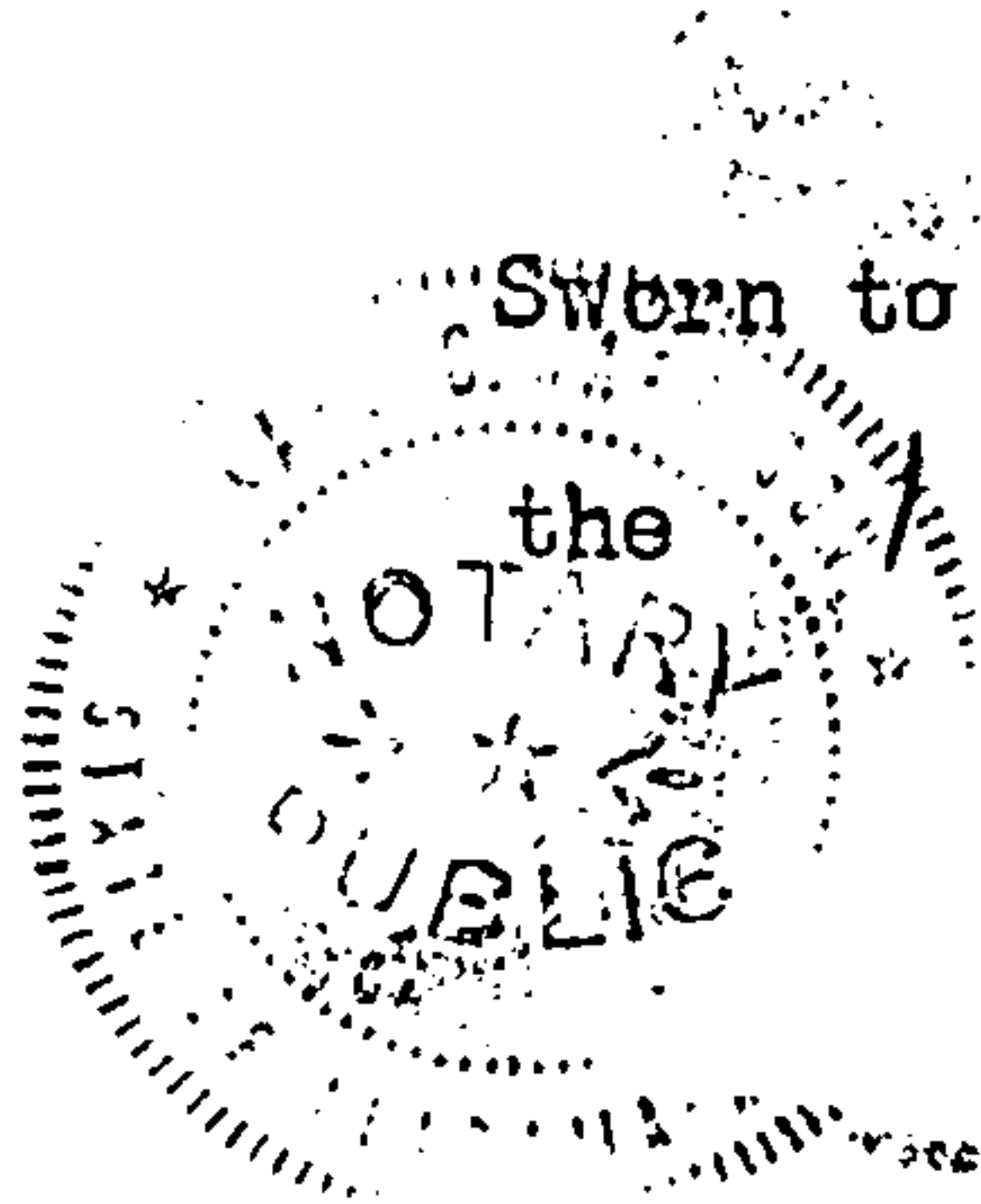
