THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into on this, the \_\_\_\_\_ day of September, 1956, by and between the undersigned, Eva C. Wooley, a widow, being the widow of J.C. Wooley, deceased; C.O. Wooley and wife, Annie F. Wooley; Harve O. Wooley, Jr., an unmarried man; Annie Belle Wooley Katz and husband, Joe Katz; Rosa Wooley, the widow of H.O. Wooley, deceased; Brooks Wooley and wife, Hazel Wooley; J.D. Wooley and wife, Vivian Wooley, party of the first part; and P.H. Wooley and wife, Helen Davis Wooley, party of the second part; the party of the first part and the party of the second part, being the widow and the sole heirs at law and next of kin, together with their husbands and wives, respectively, of J.C. Wooley, deceased,

WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, and other valuable considerations, in hand paid to the party of the first part by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, the following described real estate situated in the Town of Montevallo, in the County of Shelby, State of Alabama, to-wit:

That certain parcel of land described as commencing at the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 21, Township 22, South, Range 3 West, and run thence East along the South line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 21 for a distance of 392 feet, more or less, to the Southeast right of way line of King's Highway according to Map of Wooley Heights in the Town of Montevallo, Alabama, as shown of record in Deed Book 77, on page 443, in the office of the Judge of

Probate of Shelby County, Alabama; turn thence to the left at an angle of 74 degrees and 57 minutes, (being the deflection angle) and run in a Northeasterly direction along the Southeast right of way line of King's Highway for a distance of 512 feet to a point; run thence at an angle of 15 degrees and 36 minutes to the right, (being the deflection angle), for a distance of 175 feet along the Southeast right of way line of said King's Highway to the point of beginning of the parcel of land herein described and conveyed, and being the Northeast corner of Lot No. 26, according to the Map of Wooley Heights in the Town of Montevallo, Alabama, as aforesaid: Turn thence to the right at an angle of 90 degrees and run thence in a Southeasterly direction for a distance of 200 feet to a point; turn thence to the right at an angle of 90 degrees and run in a Southwesterly direction for a distance of 50 feet; run thence to the right and at an angle of 90 degrees and in a Northwesterly direction for a distance of 200 feet to the Southeast right of way line of said King's Highway; run thence in a Northeasterly direction along the Southeast right of way line of said King's Highway for a distance of 50 feet to the point of beginning; being all of Lots 25 and 26 according to the Map of Wooley Heights in the Town of Montevallo, Alabama, together with an additional tract contiguous thereto measuring and extending said lots for a distance of 50 feet in a Southeasterly direction .
