Before me, Wilward G McCants, the undersigned authority in and for the County of Marengo, State of Alabama, personally appeared L. L. Steinhart, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is L. L. Steinhart. I am a son-in-law of Janetta Mayer, whose name has sometime erroneously been referred to as Janette Mayer. It is my understanding that Joe Mayer purchased the following described land many years ago and I assume the deeds were given to the purchaser. Joe Mayer died before Violet 1915 and left his widow, Janetta Mayer, who also died approximately 3 months after his death. After their death I assessed the property with the idea of going up to Shelby County and looking into the matter. I was never able to get any information regarding it and a few years ago I discontinued paying taxes on the land and determined to make no further claim to it and that is my position at this time. My wife, the daughter of Joe and Janetta Mayer, died some 4 years ago. The title to said land will not be questioned by either me or my family. Said land is described as follows:
