AFFIDAVIT OF FRANK JAMES SMITH

Affiant, who by me first being duly sworn, deposes and says: My name is Frank James Smith. I am 69 years of age and live in Dogwood, Shelby County, Alabama, and have lived there for the last three years. I have lived in Shelby County, since 1932. From 1936 until I moved to my present home I lived on the following described land containing approximately fifteen acres in the house now occupied by Joe L. Honeycutt and Hattie B. Honeycutt:

> Beginning at the SW corner of the SWA of NWA of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 3 West; thence run North 873 degrees East 580 feet to point on East side of Southern Railway Company's right of way; thence run in a Northerly direction along the East right of way line of said Southern Railway right of way a distance of 460 feet to a settlement road; thence run North 873 degrees East a distance of 557 feet to a point on West right of way line of Montevallo-Elyton road; thence run North 25 degrees East along West side of said road a distance of 285 feet to a point; run thence South 85 degrees West a distance of 1276 feet to the West line of SWA of NWA; run thence South 22 degrees East 804 feet to point of beginning, excepting Highway and Railroad rights of ways.

During the time that I lived on the above property I farmed the same, keeping the entire fifteen acres under cultivation. For one year I rented six acres to James L. Lovelady for farming. During this time no one contested or disputed my title to the property.

There are no railroad right of ways or spur tracks on this property other than the Southern Railway Company right of way.
