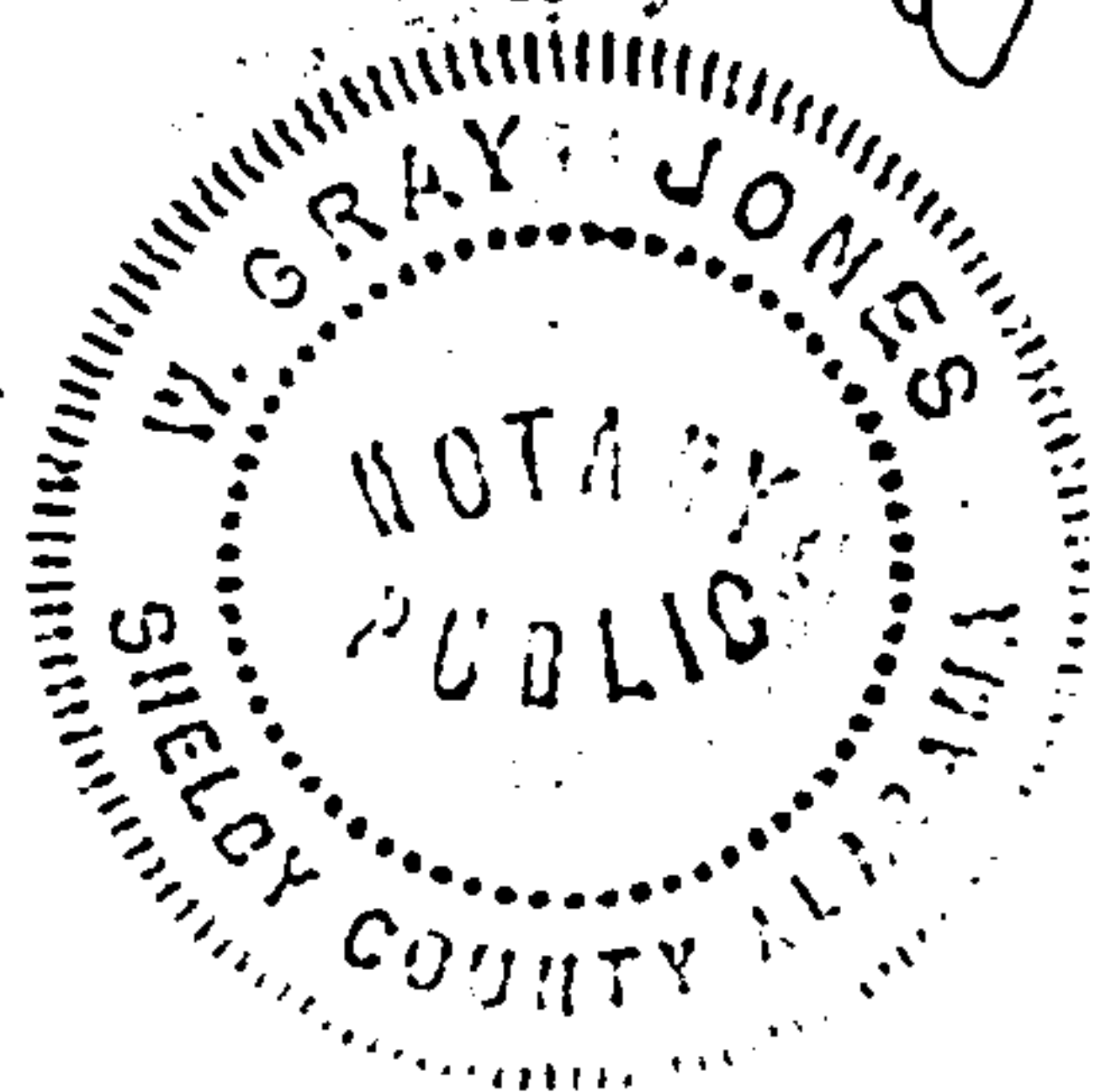
Before the undersigned authority personally appeared Albert L. Scott who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says:
