do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Norman L. West and Josie T. West

as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, the following described real estate; situated in

Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Commencing at the NW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, Township 21 South, Range 1 West; thence South 39 deg. 01' East, a distance of 1067.56 feet to the point of beginning of the property herein described; thence North 79 deg. 33' 30" East, a distance of 175.0 feet to a point; thence South 14 deg. 59' East, a distance of 210.0 feet to a point on the NW right of way line of County Highway No. 32; thence South 79 deg. 33' 30" west along said right of way line, a distance of 175.0 feet to a point; thence North 14 deg. 59' West a distance of 210.0 feet to the point of beginning; that said property is lying in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, Township 21 South, Range 1 West.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD Unto the said Norman L. West and Josie T. West

as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, their heirs and assigns forever; it being the intention of the parties to this conveyance, that (unless the joint tenancy hereby created is severed or terminated during the joint lives of the grantees herein), in the event one grantee herein survives the other, the entire interest in fee simple shall pass to the surviving grantee, and if one grantee does not survive the other, then the heirs and assigns of the grantees herein shall take as tenants in common.

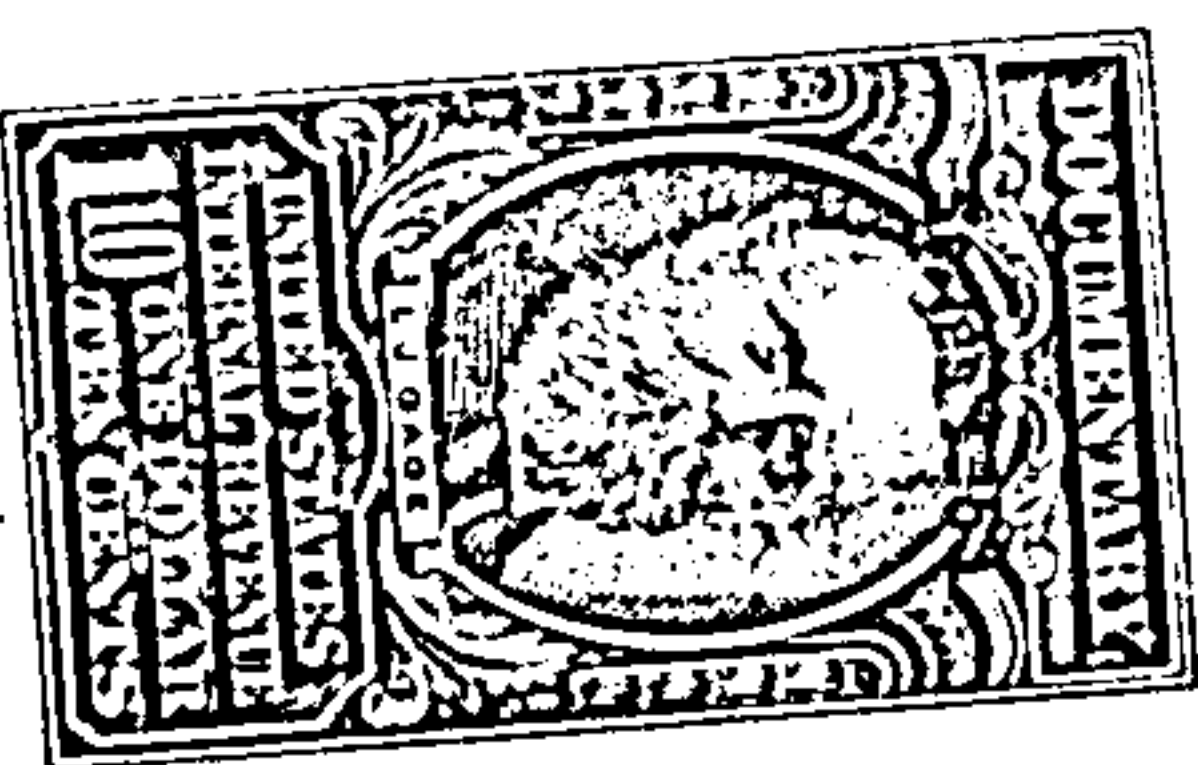
