And we do hereby ratify such act of my/our said attorney performed under these premises.

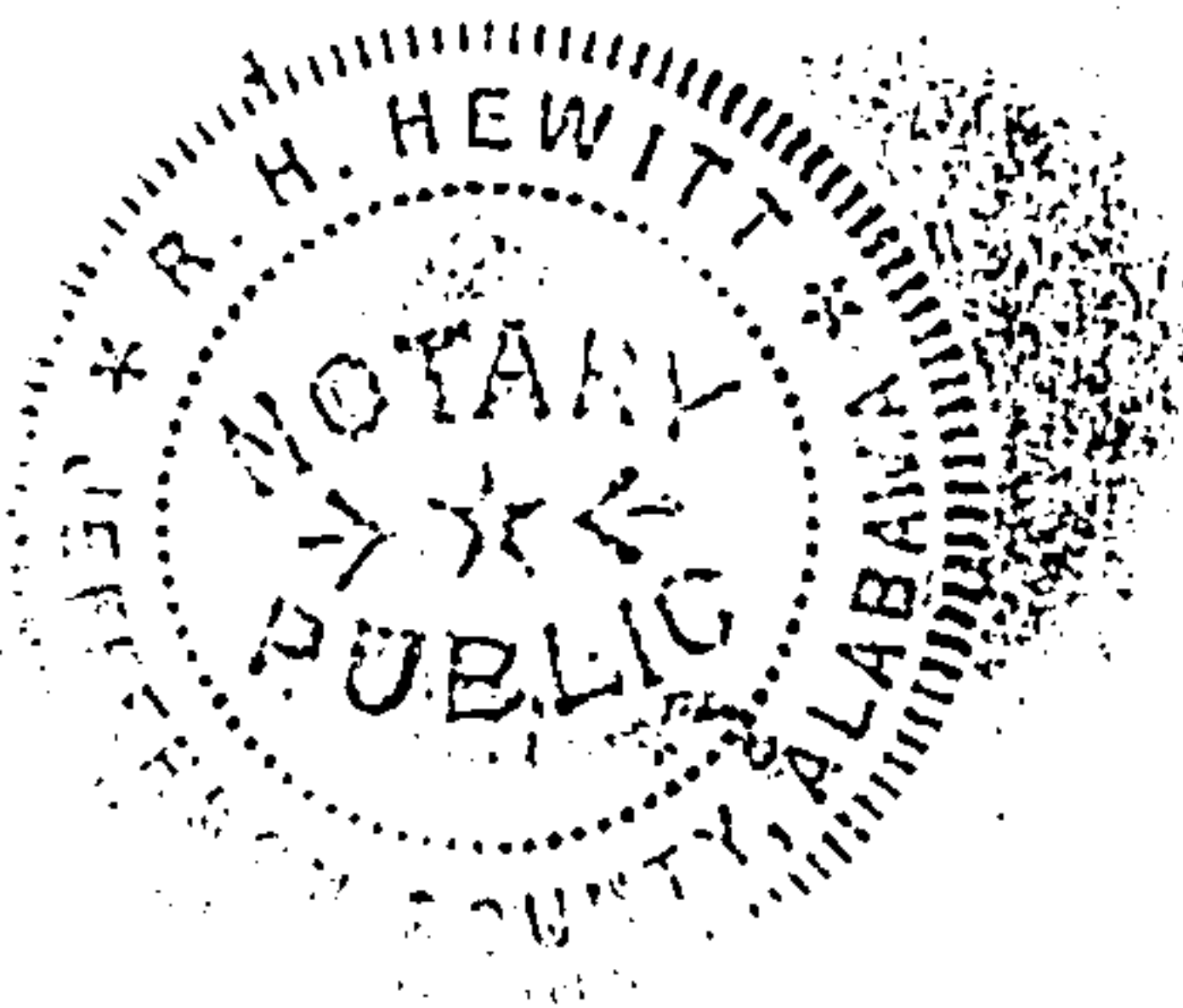
