months, with right of ingress, egress, and regress to, from and over said land for the purpose of cutting and removing said timber; but it is agreed that all timber left on said land at the expiration of said time shall rever to and become the property of said landowners, their heirs and assigns.

And said landowners to hereby covenant with said timberman, that they are the owners of said land, that it is free from encumbrance, that they have a good right to sell the timber thereon, and that he will not be molested or interferred with while cutting and removing said timber.

It is agreed and understood by and between the parties hereto that timberman is not to cut timber on the fences of landowners and if he inadvertently does
so, must immediately repair the same; timberman is to clear all tops from trees so
cut from the fields and roadways on the same day the same might be cut in such fields
and roadways.
