To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, Samuel Heer, of Shelby County,

has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Philadelphia,

whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Samuel Heer,
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the tract in the right half quarter of Section Eight, in Franklin County, Pennsylvania, in the District of Maine, lying in the State of Maine, containing One Hundred and Fifteen hundred acres of land.

According to the official plan of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Samuel Heer.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Samuel Heer, and to his heirs, the said tract above described; To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said Samuel Heer,

and to his — heirs and assigns forever.

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be affixed.
