My name is James Merritt. I was born in 1878 and have lived in Shelby County, Alabama since 1896. In the year 1925, I purchased certain land adjoining the following described land:

4 acres in the Northwest corner of NE of NE of Section 1, Township 21, Range 3 West, said land lying north of the original settlement road running across said forty acres; and being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

At that time I fenced in and took into possession said land described above, along with the other lands to which I obtained a deed. I have been in the actual possession of said land, living on it and obtaining fire wood and building timber from it each and every year until this very day and no one has ever questioned my title to said land. It is common knowledge in our community that Humphrey Griffin formerly owned said land and that he died and left a daughter surviving him and she has since died and left surviving her, George Allen, who is also dead. I have inquired in the community and have never heard of anyone who knew of any brothers or sisters of the mother of George Allen.
