KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, George R. Ozley of 1317 North 32nd. Street, Birmingham, in Jefferson County, Alabama, being over the age of twenty-one years, and being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make and publish, this, my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills which may have been made, at any time heretofore, by me.

FIRST: I will that all of my just debts and funeral expenses shall, by my Executrix hereinafter named, be paid out of my Estate as soon after my decease as convenient.

SECOND: I give, devise, and bequeath to my beloved wife, Clara B. Ozley, all of my worldly Estate, and all of the real, personal, and mixed property of which I shall die seized and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease.

THIRD: In the event that my beloved wife, Clara B. Ozley, should pre-decease me, or in the event that her decease should be simultaneous with my decease, or at substantially the same time thereof, then, I give, devise, and bequeath to my daughter, Clara Elizabeth Ozley Tower, all of my worldly Estate, and all of my real property, personal and mixed property and choses in action of which I shall die seized and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at the time of my death.

FOURTH: I nominate and appoint my beloved daughter, Clara Elizabeth Ozley Tower, as Executrix of this, my Last Will and Testament, and I hereby declare that she shall not be required to give any bond for the performance of her duties arising hereunder, nor shall such Executrix be required to make any report or financial settlement, or file any inventory, or make any appraisal, or final settlement to any Court of the property and effects coming into her hands belonging to said Estate, or in the performance of her duties arising hereunder, as such Executrix.

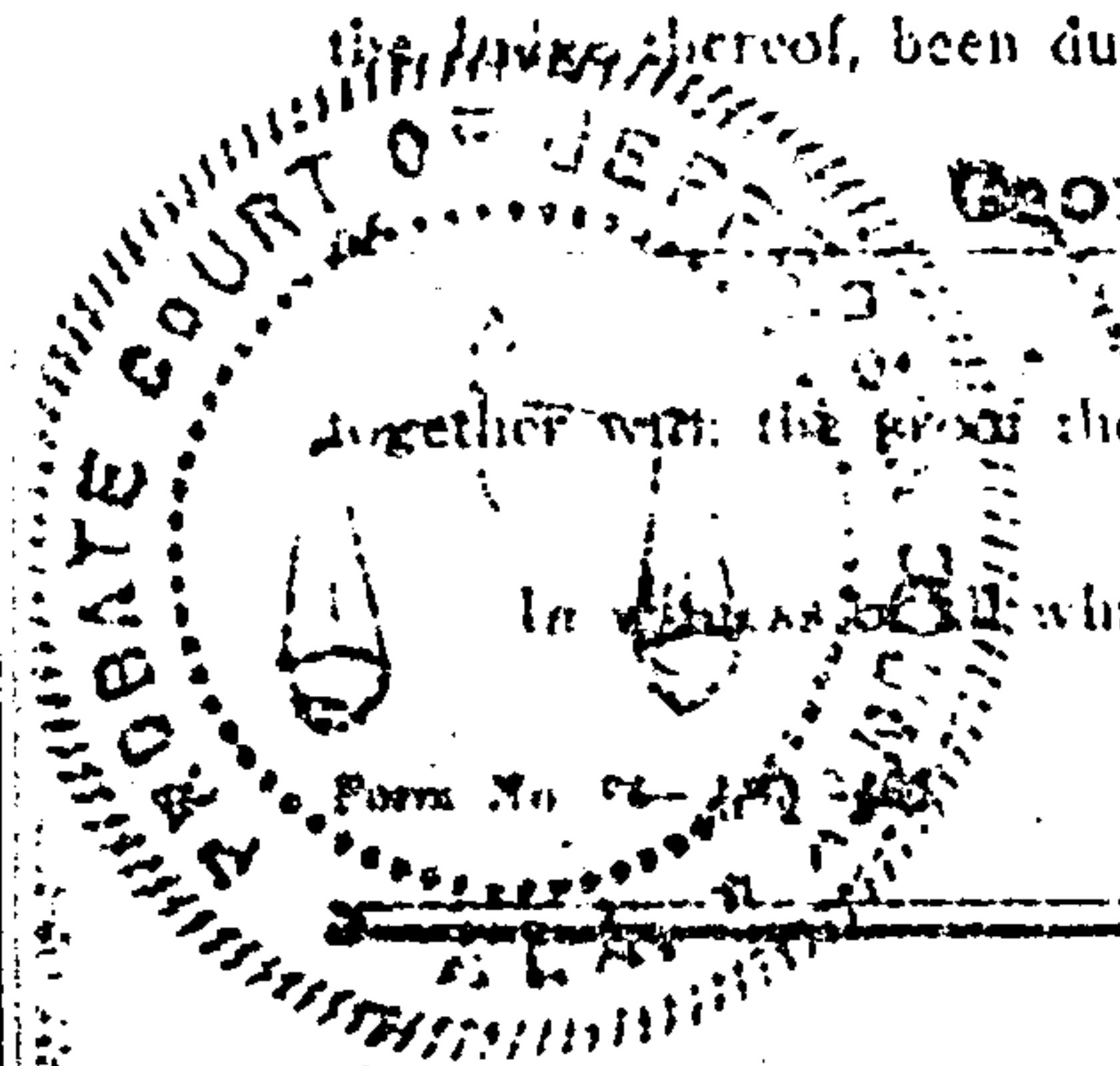

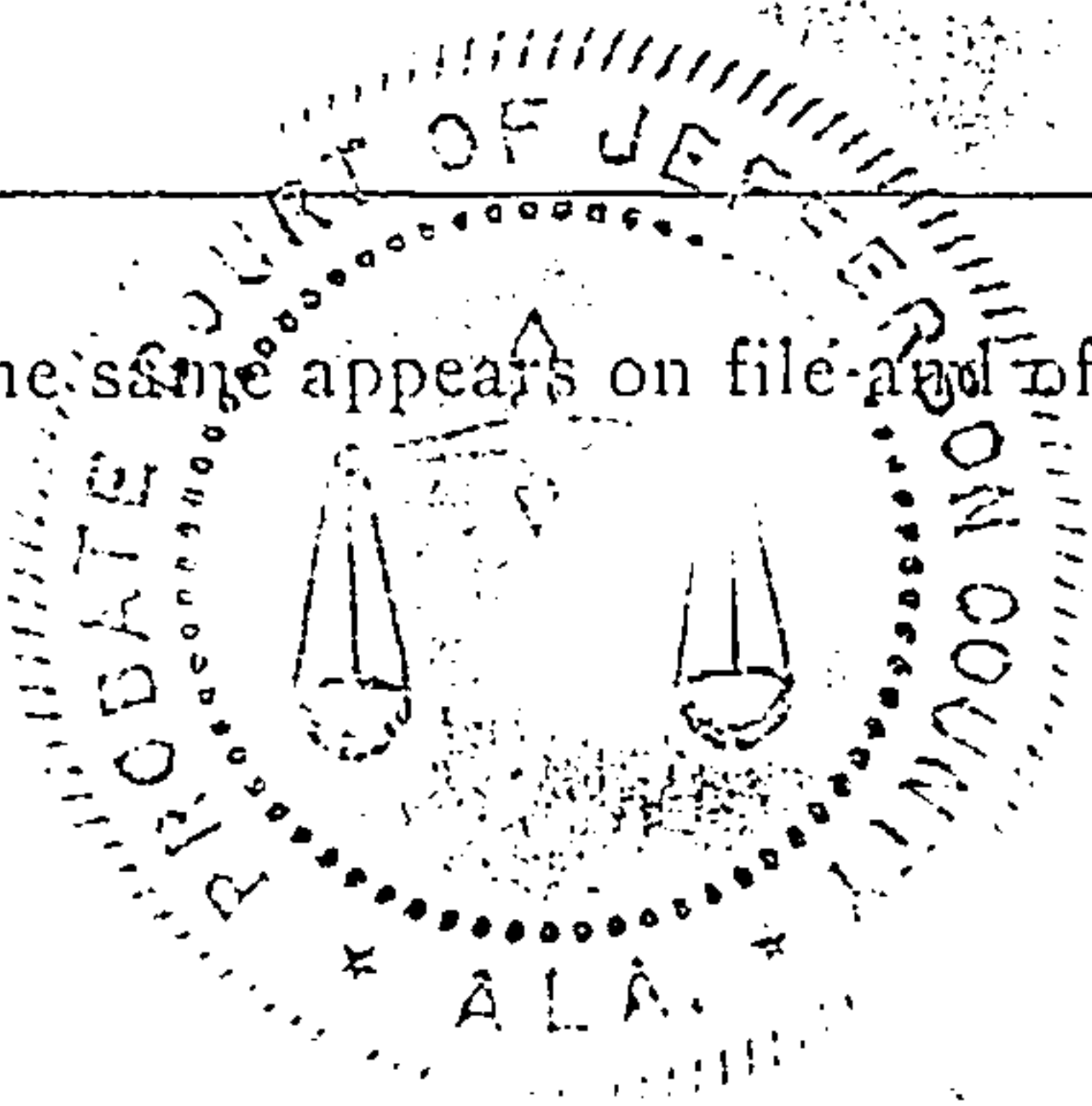
