I am acquainted with the following land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, namely:

Part of the SEŁ of NWŁ and Wł of SWŁ of NEŁ. Section 3. Township 21, Range 1 East, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point where the East margin of a road which connects State Highway No. 25 and the Blue Springs Road, intersects the North boundary of said SE# of NW# and run thence South along said East margin of said connecting road 300 feet; thence East 800 feet; the Northerly and parallel with said connecting road 300 feet to the North line of SW of NE ; thence West 800 feet to the point of beginning.

I formerly owned this small tract of land, which is carved from a larger tract of land that I owned. I was acquainted with D. G. Baker during his lifetime and at his death he was the owner of the W2 of SW4 of NE# and the SE# of NW#, Section 3, Township 21, Range 1 East. I purchased the land specifically described above, being 300 feet North and South and 800 feet East and West, from the heirs of D. G. Baker. . The first deed I obtained was from Mattie Baker Seale, an unmarried woman, J. L. Baker and wife, George M, Baker and wife, and J. D. Baker and wife, by deed dated September 13, 1938, and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby ounty, Alabama, in Deed Book 113, page 43. I also obtained a deed from Nona Baker Stinson and her husband, by deed dated November 22, 1938, and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 113, page 44. The captioned land was included in these two deeds and the grantors therein were all the heirs of said D. G. Baker, deceased.
