

Councilman Elvin Hill

introduced the following Resolution:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on May 3, 1905, A. P. Longshore and wife, Fannie T. Longshore, made a deed to J. S. Jackson covering the following described property, along with other land, which deed is recorded in Deed Book 98 Page 23 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama;

WHEREAS, in said deed there was a certain clause regarding the operation of a mill and which stated if the grantee failed to maintain and operate said mill, he should refund to the city the sum of \$295.00 with interest to said City of Columbiana, otherwise, the title to said lot shall rest in said City of Columbiana;

WHEREAS, there is no further reference to this agreement on the records of the City of Columbiana or on the records of the Probate Judge of Shelby County;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council desire to execute such papers as are necessary to make proper conveyances of any right, title or interest it might have in said land under or by virtue of said deed mentioned hereinabove;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COLUMBIANA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute such additional papers, including a quit claim deed, as is desired by the present owner of said land described in the above mentioned deed.

Said resolution was read at length and thereupon Councilman Francis Leonard moved that unanimous consent of the Mayor and Council be given for the immediate consideration of, and action upon said resolution, which motion was seconded by Councilman James T. McDow. Said motion for unanimous consent was submitted to a vote of the Mayor and Council and said vote resulted as follows:

NAYS None.

Thereupon, the Mayor in open council declared said motion carried and unanimous consent given for the immediate consideration of and action upon said resolution.

Councilman Francis Leonard moved that said resolution be adopted, which motion was seconded by Councilman Elvin Hill. Said motion for the adoption of said resolution was submitted to a vote of the Mayor and Council and said vote resulted as follows:
