Armstrong who, being by me first duly sworn, says that continuously for the past 20 years he has lived upon and cultivated the West Half of the Northwest Quarter ($W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 17, Township 18, Range 1, East, Shelby County, Alabama, as a tenant of the Modern Farm & Cattle Company; that during that time no person has claimed any right to or interest in said land except said landlord; that Mrs. F. C. Whitehead, who was the mother of F. E. Whitehead, died about 13 years ago; that her son F. E. Whitehead married Miss Vera Lee and after the death of F. E.
