KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT for valuable consideration, we, Clyde F. Weaver and wife, Guarita Belle Weaver, hereby release and discharge from the mortgage made by Gladys M. Weaver, dated March 13, 1954, securing Two Thousand Dollars, and recorded in Mortgage Book Volume 231, on page 494, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, to secure the payment of Two Thousand Dollars, the following described tract or parcel of land, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, and described as follows:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, and all that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 7, Township 20, South, Range 2 West, lying South and Southeast of the public road, known as Fungo Hollow Public Road, and as now located in that part of the above described lands described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 7, and run thence South along the West line of said forty acres and along the West line of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 7, to a point which is 900 feet North of the Southwest corner of said Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter; run thence East in a Southeasterly direction to a point on the East line of said Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 7, which said point is 600 feet North of the Southeast corner of said last named forty acres; run thence North to the Northeast corner of said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 7; run thence West along the North line of said forty acres to the Northwest corner thereof, being the point of beginning and the lands herein released being all of the lands described in the above and foregoing description which lie South and Southeast of said Fungo Hollow Public Road in the above description.

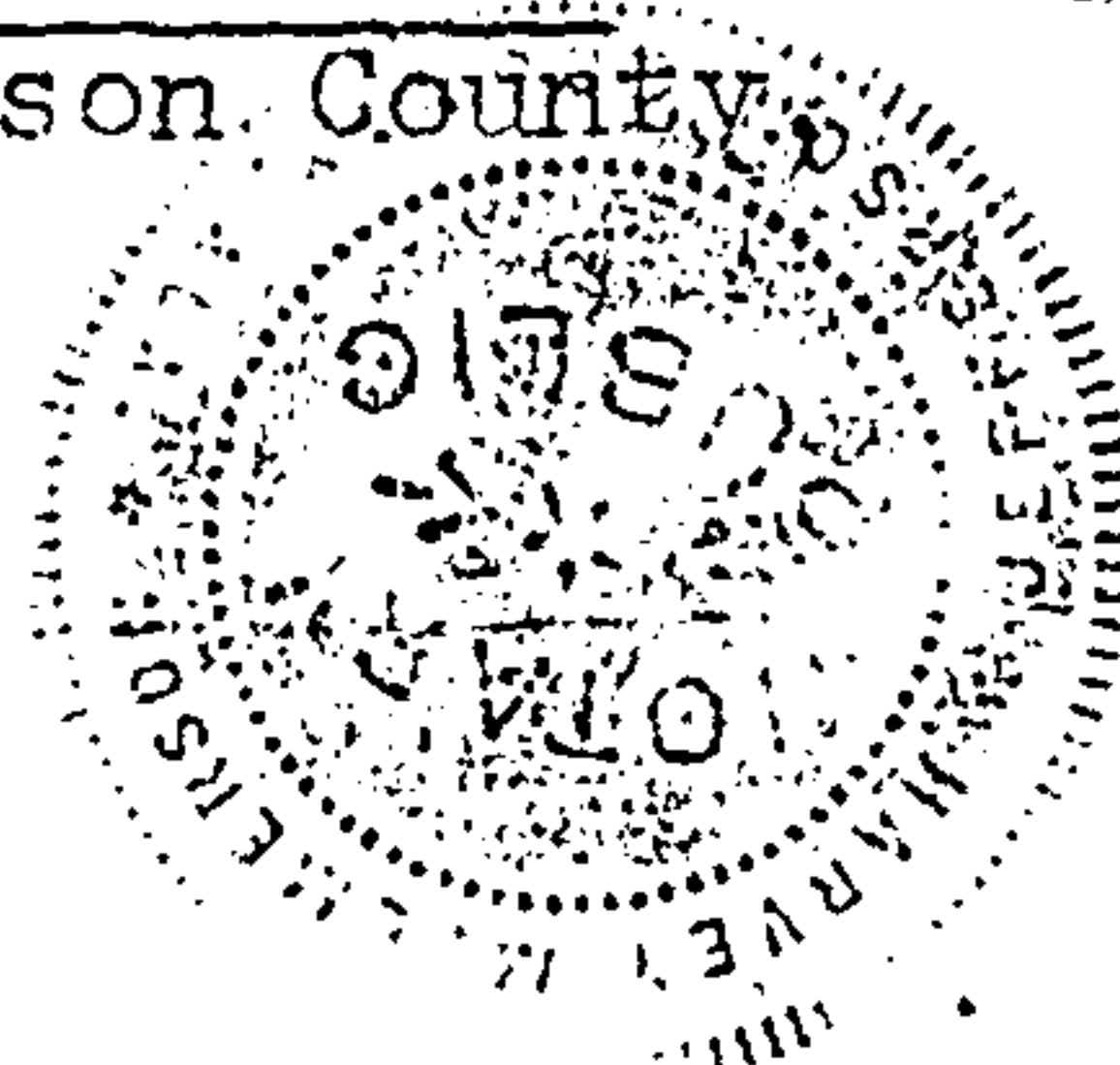
