On the 8th day of August, 1942, W. Royce Morris, who was then a single man, deeded to B. H. Morris, the following property situated in Shelby County, Alabama, namely:

All that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, Township 21, Range 1 East, which lies North and East of what is known as the Mooney Road, containing two acres, more or less.

The above mentioned deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 189, page 112.

There is a dwelling house situated on the strip of land deeded to B. H. Morris and said B. H. Morris has been in the actual, open, notorious, exclusive, continuous, adverse, hostile possession of said strip of land from August 8, 1942, to the present time, either living upon it himself or having tenants on it down to the present time.

My husband, W. Royce Morris owns the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, Township 21, Range 1 East, except the strip of land he deeded to B. H. Morris as aforesaid.
